Public Hearings

7. Tentative Parcel Map (TPM) 18-01 (Hilbers/Jones Properties LLC): Proposal to subdivide a 2.02-acre parcel into five commercial parcels ranging in size from 0.28 acre to 0.69 acres.

The proposal is to subdivide a 2.02-acre parcel into five commercial lots ranging in size from 0.28 acre to 0.69 acre. Two of the proposed parcels are already developed with the Waffle House Restaurant and the Java Retreat Coffee drive-through business. Three of the proposed parcels are undeveloped.

Mailed notices of the Council hearings will be accomplished in the same manner as the Planning Commission hearings unless additional notice is deemed necessary.
