Public Hearing

5. Public hearing to consider Use Permit 19-03 to allow for the construction of an 82' tall monopine, wireless telecommunication facility located at 890 Von Geldern Way.

Recommendation: Conduct a public hearing and make the necessary findings to:

Adopt a Resolution approving Use Permit 19-03 and Environmental Assessment 19-14, to allow the construction of a new wireless telecommunication facility exceeding standard zoning height limitations at 890 Von Geldern Way, Yuba City, subject to making the necessary findings, and with the Conditions of Approval.

Item called and staff made a presentation on the proposed project. The applicant, Kevin Gallagher, was present to help answer questions from the Planning Commission and/or public.

The public was given an opportunity to speak on the item and no public comments were received.

After the public hearing was closed, and deliberation, Commissioner Ali made a comment that it is apparent the monopine tower will be your view when driving into Yuba City, instead of the Sutter Buttes. Additionally, the screening doesn't seem to be the resolution.

A motion to approve the Recommendation with the following revisions to the Conditions of Approval was made by Commissioner Shannon:

- Conditions of Approval #5: add "in substantial compliance with the approved project." to the existing condition.
- Add Condition of Approval #8: If the project foundation is deeper than five feet, the applicant shall provide a Geotech report and foundation design that is to be routed and approved by the Sutter Butte Flood Control Agency and Levee District 1 prior to issuance of the building permit.
- Add Condition of Approval #9: Applicant and/or owner is required to perform regular upkeep and maintenance of the total facility, including but not limited to the faux branches.

Commissioner Doscher seconded the motion.

The vote passed 5-1, with Commissioner Ali voting no.

Development Services Director Reports

Benjamin Moody provided the following updates to the Planning Commission:

- Planning Commission meeting on October 14th is cancelled, and most likely October 28th
- Harter Development is currently in process with City staff
- DD's Discounts permit is on hold
- Richland Housing: 170+ unit complex, along Garden Highway and Percy wants to be entitled for grant deadlines.
- Clark Avenue location has been demolished
- 7-Eleven application is currently incomplete with applicant working on revisions to resubmit
- Proposed Chevron changing scope of work and will resubmit plans
- Holiday Inn working on revisions for plan checks
- Signage updates for Yuba Sutter Mall

- Truck yard was proposed and is in the process of being constructed
- Left turn at 20, due to construction restraints received an 18-month extension for paving
