2	Ravi Jawanda	Appendix 2A under table 1-YC TAC members; my name is not listed there either. Please update that to include the State Water Boards involvement. Please refer to item 2.1 in our agreement.	Appendix 2A is the stakeholder and outreach plan that was submitted in October, and therefore should remain as is. However, we added a note to the cover page of Appendix 2A that says:  "Note: Ravinder Jawanda, the State Grant Manager, was not listed as a TAC member in the submittal included in the following Appendix, however, she was an active TAC member throughout the SWRP development and has been acknowledged in the SWRP report."
3	Ravi Jawanda	Please make sure that in any of the other attachments where it discusses the TAC members it includes me as well, which I have noticed it doesn't.	The appendices are generally documents that were submitted during the SWRP development process and therefore, should remain as is. However, we added the comment 2 note to the cover page of Appendix 2B.

6	Nick Ramos	For Table ES-1 [303(d) listed waterbodies] is impairment tied to a year?	Effective dates of discharge restrictions for specific contaminants are estimated in the 303(d) list, but were not included in Table ES-1. Dates of impairment of the water body are not listed in the 303(d) list. No changes to Table ES-1 were made.
