ELECTION SUMMARY

DATE OF ELECTION

Tuesday, November 4, 2014. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This election will be consolidated with Sutter County, who will print and mail the sample ballots, determine polling places and precinct officers, process absentee ballot applications, and conduct the tabulation (canvass) of the votes.

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

All candidates must be 18 years of age, a Citizen of the United States, and a registered voter residing within the City limits.

NOMINATION PERIOD

Opens: Monday, July 14, 2014

Closes: Friday, August 8, 2014, unless an incumbent does not file, then the period is extended to

Wednesday, August 13, 2014.

NOMINATION PAPERS AND / OR CANDIDATES GUIDE

Nomination papers will be available starting on the first day of the nomination period, Monday, July 14, 2014, in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Pulling nomination papers will take approximately 30 minutes.

COST

There is no cost to pull nomination papers.

Those candidates that choose to have a candidate statement printed in the sample ballot pay for the printing of that statement, which is estimated to be \$440.00.
