Fire Recruits and Firefighters engage in firefighting and fire prevention activities in protecting life and property; operate and maintain fire apparatus, rescue vehicles, and firefighting equipment and perform other related work as required. Employees work rotating, 24 hour shifts, including holidays and weekends as part of the schedule. Employees may be required to respond to emergency call backs.

Both full-time permanent and limited-term (SAFER Grant) positions may be filled through this recruitment. Placement of qualifying candidates is at the discretion of the Fire Department.

Required Qualifications

Fire Recruit:

<u>Educational and/or experience requirements:</u> Completion of formal or informal education sufficient to ensure the ability to read and write at a level for successful job performance; no experience required.

<u>Licenses and/or Certifications Required:</u> Possession of a current and valid CPAT card, State required CPR Certificate, valid State of California Emergency Medical Technician I (E.M.T.) Certificate or a valid State of California Paramedics Certificate, and a valid California Class C driver's license. In addition to a Class C license, the candidate is required to have a valid and current Class B license or upon hire, must successfully complete the required classroom, and behind the wheel Firefighter endorsement training and successfully pass the DMV written and Yuba City Fire Department behind the wheel testing process.

NOTE: Copies of all Licenses/Certifications must be submitted at Written Testing. Applicants who fail to provide the required documentation will be automatically disqualified from the selection process.

Additional requirements for Firefighter I:

Completion of the Firefighter I Manual and successfully completed the training and testing required at the Fire Recruit level, and have a minimum of six (6) months of full time firefighting experience with the Yuba City Fire Department or a minimum of one (1) year recent active experience as a volunteer, paid-call or reserve firefighter or a minimum of one (1) year experience as a student firefighter intern with an approved fire agency.
