Summary

Subject: **Five (5) Crown Victoria Police Interceptors (FB 08-07)**
Recommendation: Award the purchase of five (5) Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors to the low bidder, Geweke Ford of Yuba City, CA for \$127,690.55.
Fiscal Impact: \$127,690.55 Vehicle Replacement Fund account # 6610-69405.

Background:

To purchase replacement patrol cars for the City's Police Department.

Analysis:

General Services' staff worked with the Police Department to ensure that the vehicle specifications meet the City's requirements. A formal bid was developed and advertised according to the City's ordinances. Ten (10) vendors received bid notification. The following bids were received:

Downtown Ford Sales Sacramento, CA	\$27,287.79	\$136,438.95

Fiscal Impact:

Funding for this purchase has been appropriated in the FY08 budget and is available in the Vehicle Replacement Fund account # 6610-69405. The account has a balance of \$238,853.30, so sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

- 3) Do not purchase

Recommendation:

Award the purchase to from Larry Geweke Ford of Yuba City, CA, for five (5) Crown Victoria Police Interceptors in the amount of 127,690.55.
