**Summary**

**Subject:** Completion of the 2006 Storm Damage Repairs to the Yuba City Wastewater Effluent Discharge Ponds.

**Recommendation:** Adopt a Resolution to accept the completion of the "2006 Storm Damage Repairs to the Yuba City Wastewater Effluent Discharge Ponds" project (07-11) and authorize Utilities Director to file a Notice of Completion.

**Fiscal Impact:** The City Council authorized \$1,000,000 for the project completion. The project was completed for \$949,233.57. Staff has submitted to FEMA a reimbursement request for all expenditures.

**Background:**

The Wastewater Treatment Facility's operates 140 acres of effluent discharge ponds located within Feather River floodway. Sutter County was declared a Federal Disaster Area during the January 2006 storm events. During this storm event the Wastewater Treatment Facility's effluent discharge ponds were inundated and erosion occurred to the pond berms, water level control structures, and rip-rap.

The City Council awarded the Contract to DeWitt Bros. & Co. Inc. of Yuba City (Formal Bid 07-11) for \$909,043 to repair these Discharge Ponds on July 2, 2007.

**Analysis:**

Based on final inspection, the repair to the Yuba City Wastewater Facility Effluent Discharge Ponds and access road is complete.

**Fiscal Impact:**

The City Council authorized \$1,000,000 for the project completion. The project was completed for \$949,233.57.

Per Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) guidelines the project is considered a large project and will be reimbursed 100% of actual construction costs. The project has already been approved and obligated by FEMA and OES (Governor's Office of Emergency Services). City staff has submitted a reimbursement request for all expenditures.


**Alternatives:**

**Recommendation:**



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY  
ACCEPTING THE WORK PERFORMED UNDER THE 2006 STORM DAMAGE REPAIRS TO  
THE YUBA CITY DISCHARGE PONDS PROJECT (CONTRACT NO. 07-11), AND DIRECTING  
THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AND RECORD A NOTICE OF COMPLETION**

WHEREAS, the City of Yuba City has heretofore contracted with DeWitt Bros. & Co. Inc. for certain work performed under that project known as the 2006 Storm Damage Repairs to the Yuba City Discharge Ponds Project, being Contract No. 07-11; and

WHEREAS, said work of improvement as called for by the contract between the City of Yuba City and DeWitt Bros. & Co. Inc., referable to said project was completed on October 22, 2007, to the satisfaction of the City; and

WHEREAS, there has been posted, and the City Council so recited, as required by the General Conditions of the said project specifications Section 13.07, the Contractor is responsible for any defects in the work of improvements for a period of one (1) year from and after completion.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Yuba City that it hereby accepts the work performed on those certain improvements, the subject of a contract between the City of Yuba City and DeWitt Bros. & Co. Inc., known and referred to as the 2006 Storm Damage Repairs to the Yuba City Discharge Ponds Project and authorizes and directs the Utilities Director of the City of Yuba City to execute and record a Notice of Completion in connection with said work of improvement.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly introduced, passed, and adopted by the City Council of the City of Yuba City at a regular meeting thereof held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2007.
