Summary

Subject: 2008 Water Main Extension Project

Recommendation:

- a. Award Contract No. 08-10, 2008 Water Main Extension Project, to Newland Entities, Inc., of Yuba City, CA in the amount of their bid of \$122,500.
- b. Authorize the City Manager to execute the contract on behalf of the City, following approval by the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact: \$147,000 – Account No. 97003 (Water Line Extension Project), broken down as follows:

- \$122,500 – contract award amount
- \$24,500 – construction contingency

Background:

The 2008 Water Main Extension Project consists of extending an existing water distribution main in Bridge Street from Mark Thomas Drive to Harding Road. Refer to Exhibit A. This new water main in Bridge Street will complete a loop of the water distribution system in this area.

On April 15, 2008, Council approved the plans and specifications for this project and also authorized the Public Works Department to advertise for bids.

Analysis:

The 2008 Water Main Extension Project was advertised for bid in April and May 2008. Plans and specifications were provided to local builder/contractor exchanges and purchased by 20 contractors/suppliers. On May 21, 2008, thirteen bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office. The three lowest bids and engineer's estimate are shown below. Complete bid results are attached as Appendix A to this staff report.

Down Under Construction & Engineering, Rocklin	\$135,701.00
Hill & Hill Contracting, Inc., Yuba City	\$143,949.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$175,000.00

Newland Entities, Inc., of Yuba City is the low bidder. Contract administration and inspection of the pipeline project will be performed by Public Works Department staff. Project construction is expected to begin in July and continue through early August.

Fiscal Impact:

Funding for the 2008 Water Main Extension Project will come from the Water CIP Projects Fund. The Fiscal Year 2007-08 Capital Improvement Program budget accounted for this project through Account No. 97003 (Water Line Extension Projects). There is approximately \$890,000 available in this account at this time.


Alternatives:

Do not award the contract and reject all bids.
