Summary

Subject: **Five (5) Crown Victoria Police Interceptors (FB10-03)**
Recommendation: Award the purchase of five (5) Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors to the low bidder, Hoblit Motors of Woodland, CA for \$123,703.15.
Fiscal Impact: \$123,703.15 Vehicle Replacement Fund account # 6610-69405.

Background:

To purchase five (5) replacement patrol cars for the City's Police Department.

Analysis:

General Services' staff worked with the Police Department to ensure that the vehicle specifications meet the City's requirements. A formal bid was developed and advertised according to the City's ordinances. Ten (10) vendors received bid notification. The following bids were received:


Alternatives:
