**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY
SUPPORTING THE RETENTION OF THE MARYSVILLE PROCESSING
AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITY**

WHEREAS, the 10-county region served by the Marysville Processing Distribution Facility has grown rapidly over the last few years; and

WHEREAS, the loss of 200 jobs in the current economy will exacerbate unemployment levels in the Yuba-Sutter area; and

WHEREAS, once the economy improves, housing development is expected to continue in the Yuba-Sutter area and new residents who will require mail service; and

WHEREAS, previous postal service studies conducted this decade have indicated that facilities in Sacramento are unable to handle mail sorting efficiently as the award-winning efficiency provided by the Marysville Processing and Distribution Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Yuba City unanimously supports the retention of the Marysville Processing & Distribution Facility.
