Summary

Subject: CDBG Sidewalk Improvements Project FY 2009-2010 (Plans & Specifications)

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution approving the plans and specifications for the CDBG Sidewalk Improvements Project FY 2009-2010 and authorizing advertisement for bids on the project. (Estimated Project Cost \$273,000)

Fiscal Impact: Engineer's Estimate \$273,000 – Account No. 961063 (Sidewalk Improvements)

Background:

The Public Works Department is moving forward with the design of sidewalk improvements at various locations in Yuba City. These improvements are part of the City's ongoing program to provide accessibility to all pedestrians using City streets through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This project includes the installation or upgrade of 27 pedestrian access ramps at various locations near Yuba City High School and King Avenue Elementary School. The project also involves the construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter to repair out of compliance facilities on Cooper Avenue to provide continuous routes of accessibility. Exhibit A and Exhibit B show specific project area locations.

Project design, management, and construction inspection will be administered by the City's Public Works Department.

Analysis:

Public Works has prepared the plans, specifications, and estimates for the CDBG Sidewalk Improvements Project FY 2009-2010. The project involves the installation of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant pedestrian access ramps in addition to the construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter.

With Council approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to bid, staff proposes to move forward with the subject project at the following anticipated schedule, weather permitting:

Advertise for bid:	January 20 – February 18, 2010
Award Contract:	March 2, 2010
Start of construction:	March 2010
Completion:	May 2010

The plans and specifications for the project are on file in the Public Works office for review.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated construction cost is \$273,000. In the Fiscal Year 2009-10 Capital Improvement Program, there is sufficient Community Development Block Grant funds budgeted through Account No. 961063 to cover the estimated \$273,000 required for this project.



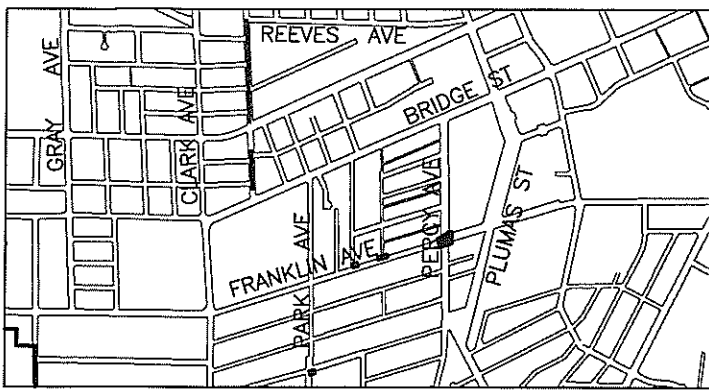

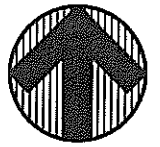

CDBG SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FY 2009-2010

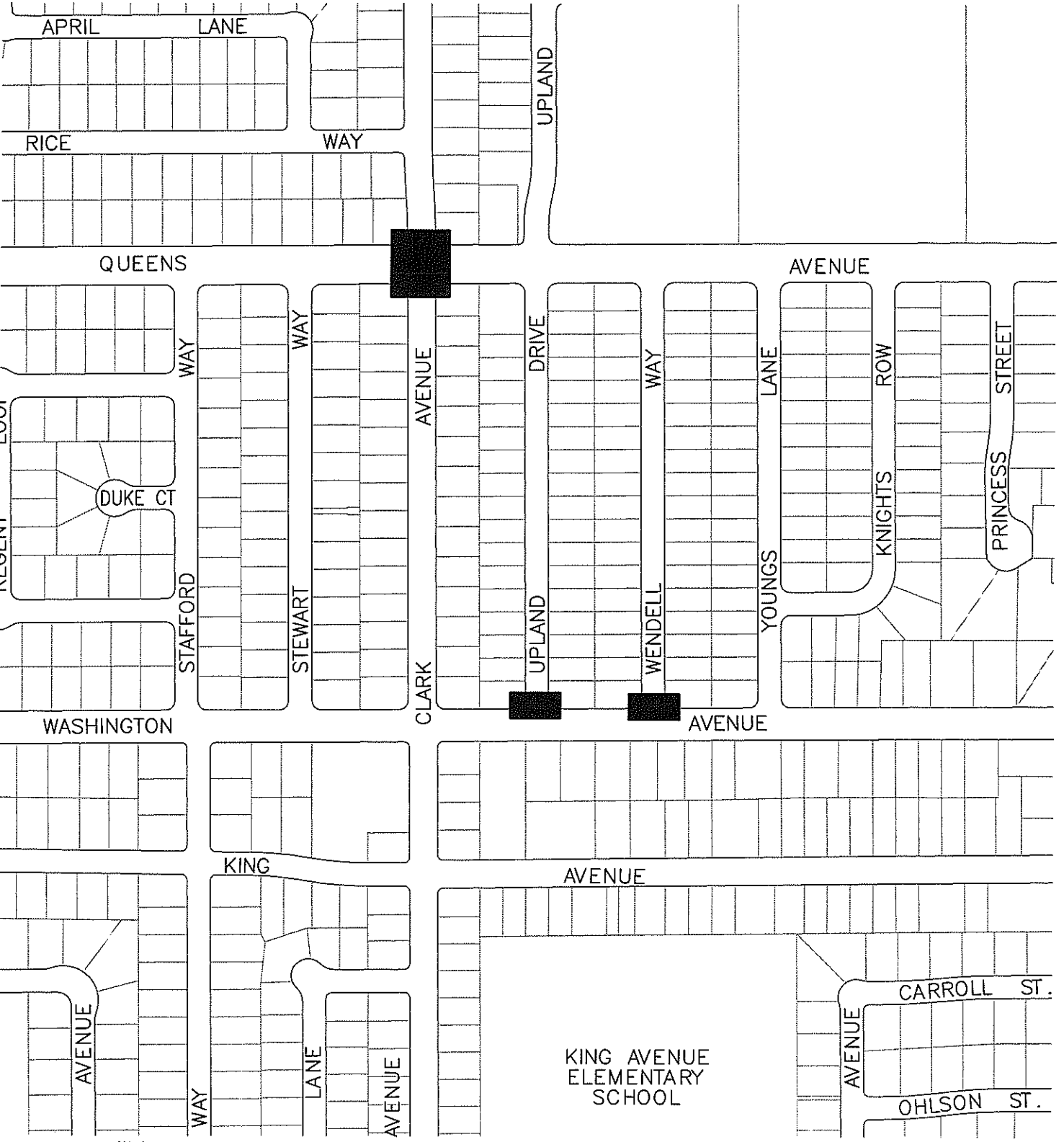
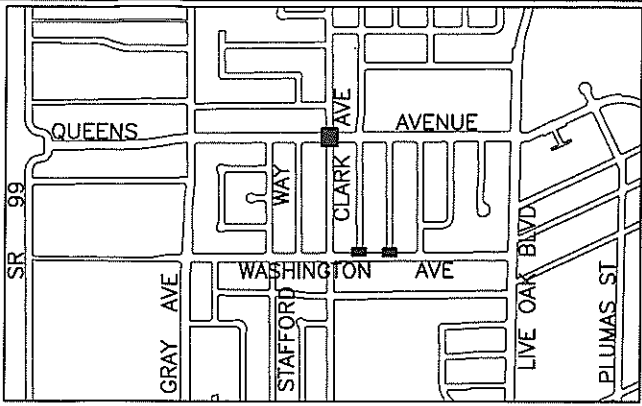
