All Hazard Mitigation Plan

- The Sutter County/Yuba City All Hazard Mitigation Plan was approved by the California Office of Emergency Services in May 2007. The Office of Emergency Services accepted the plan as submitted by staff and did not request any changes before forwarding the plan to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final approval. After federal approval, staff will request adoption of the plan by City Council. The plan provides us with useful resources in responding to emergency situations in Sutter County and Yuba City. This work has the added benefit of reducing future flood insurance costs for residents. The plan was completed using grant funding acquired by the Yuba City Fire Department.

Human Resources

- The Human Resources Department partnered with Occu Med, a company which specializes in proprietary systems for conducting pre-placement and return to work medical examinations. A study was conducted by Occu Med as an effort to update the City's medical profiles for pre-employment and return to work examinations. This is important as prior studies have found that employees returning to work early, under light duty, recover more quickly. Several employees of various departments participated in the Yuba City study. Their responses will assist Occu Med in updating our profiles to ensure accuracy and current information is included. Thank you to all who participated in this study.

Sunsweet/Geweke Crossing

- Staff is working with Sunsweet, Inc. on the reassignment of remnant parcels, leftover from the construction of Sunsweet Blvd. Some minor land holdings need to be cleaned up to finalize this project. This includes right-of-way, parking lot, and surplus parcel designations. The property use adjustments are all that remain of a very successful project for local business.
