SUBJ: **City Manager's Weekly Report**

Public Safety

- **Police/Fire:** Chief Doscher and Chief Boomgaarden presented a *State of the City/Public Safety Perspective* to the Chamber of Commerce Breakfast on Friday. It was very well received by those in attendance.
- **Police:** The Appeal Democrat will be doing a feature story on the capability of Yuba City's 911 Dispatch Center being one of the few in the State which now has the technology to accept a majority of wireless 911 calls for service, with the ability to plot the callers location in most instances.
- KUBA radio is planning an hour long feature on the Police Department's impact on local gangs, with corresponding high numbers of arrests and a drastic reduction in gang related crimes.
- Chief Doscher has been invited to appear on COMCAST Local Edition by the COMCAST government liaison manager in Sacramento. (This is the insert they play during CNN etc.). The topic will be technological advancements in the department and addressing growth within our region.

Housing

- The State of California's Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reserved \$600,000 for Yuba City for 2007 CalHome First Time Homebuyer program. This award is part of the funds available as result of the passage of Proposition 1C. These funds will be dedicated to promoting homeownership opportunities for first-time homebuyers in Yuba City through the acquisition of new or resale homes.
