SUBJ: **City Manager's Weekly Report**

### **Public Works**

- **Franklin Road Water Line:** Twenty-four bids were received for construction of a 16-inch diameter waterline on Franklin Road between Harding and Ohleyer Roads. TerraCon Pipelines of Healdsburg, CA is the low bidder at a cost of \$261,737.00. This is almost \$18,000 below the engineer's estimate of \$280,000. This pipeline project is in support of Fire Station No. 4 scheduled for bid opening on March 13.
- **Yuba City Police Department Expansion:** Twelve bids were received for the Police Department expansion project with the lowest bidder being Randy Hill Construction of Chico, CA at a cost of \$1,975,941. This is almost \$900,000 below the engineer's estimate for the project of \$2.8 million. Public Works will be administering the contract and will be presenting the contract to the Council for award shortly. Construction is anticipated to start in April of this year and be completed by the end of the year.
- **Plumas Streetscape Project:** Phase I of Plumas Street, between Bridge and Center Streets, was opened for vehicular traffic this week. Public Works staff and the Council Ad-Hoc Committee (Miller and Ramirez) met on February 15, 2008 with the Plumas Street merchants to discuss the project progress and options for proceeding with Phase II. The merchants agreed that Phase II project limits be extended to Church Street and the street be closed for vehicular traffic between Center and Church on February 25, 2008. It is hoped that the revised work plan will advance the project opening to November of '08.
