Recreation

- **Track and Field** - Track and Field was a huge success this year! We had 220 participants, ten teams, from Yuba City, Marysville, and Beale Air Force Base. Track and Field ran from March 15 - April 5th. Track season will officially end with the Hershey Track and Field event on May 31, 2008. Hershey deadline to register is on May 8 by 6pm.
- **Mighty Mite Soccer** – The inaugural year of Mighty Mite Soccer began on March 15th and ended on April 12. With a fabulous enrollment of 240 children between the ages of 4-7, the program was VERY well received by the community. Games were played at the YC High School Football Field on the new “Astro Turf” using smaller balls and goals.
- **Mighty Mite T-Ball** – Mighty Mite T-Ball is off to a great start for 2008! Practice began on April 7 with the first games taking place on Saturday, April 19. With 290 participants, children are either learning the basics of the sport or following the butterflies! Either way, they are having a great time! All Mighty Mite programs run for 5-6 weeks and teach the fundamentals of the sport.
- **Centennial Tour through Time** – The “Tour through Time” Historical Home Tour took place on April 12. This event celebrated some of the oldest homes in the city. The tour was a huge success with approximately 130 tickets sold. Money raised will go towards the Centennial Closing Ceremonies that will take place on Friday, October 10, on Plumas Street.
- **Gauche Aquatic Park** is opening for weekend Public Open Swim beginning Saturday, May 3rd and Sunday, May 4th from Noon – 2:30 pm and 3:30.
