SUBJ: **City Manager's Weekly Report**

City Council

- The City Council and Executive Team participated in a special study session on Friday to discuss the City's **Goals and Priorities** for FY 2009-10. Staff provided an overview of Flood Control, Economic Development, Transportation and Infrastructure improvements, as well as the new Gang Enforcement Task Force accomplishments. These issues were reconfirmed as top priorities for City Council and staff. The complete list of priorities will be available on the City's website in the near future.

Utilities

- This week Utilities Department staff hosted over one-hundred 4th and 5th grade students from Kynoch Elementary School in Marysville. The students were provided a complete tour of the **Wastewater Treatment Facility**, including the lab and operations center, and were taken step by step through the wastewater treatment process. Staff provided the students an opportunity to have hands on microscope training where they viewed the various microorganisms that aid in the treatment process.

Public Works

- **Queens Avenue & Stabler Lane Signal Project.** Construction for the Queens Avenue and Stabler Lane Signal Project is substantially complete. The signal was successfully turned on Thursday, March 19th.
- **CDBG Sidewalk Improvements 2008 Project.** C&C Construction of Rocklin, CA is nearing completion of the CDBG Sidewalk Improvements 2008 Project. This project included 25 pedestrian access ramps in the King Avenue Elementary Area, sidewalk improvements and 18 ramps in the Park Avenue Elementary Area in addition to sidewalk improvements along Franklin Avenue, behind Yuba City High School. Full project completion is expected by the end of March.
