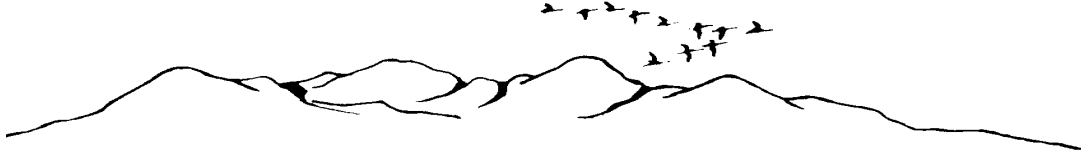
Parks and Recreation

- **RFP Process for Old Fire Station #4.** The YMCA was the only proposal received for the potential use of Old Fire Station #4. Currently, staff is reviewing the proposal and compiling a list of questions and clarifications for the President and CEO. YMCA will present to a committee made up of Parks and Recreation Commissioners and Youth Commissioners on Monday, March 8th at 7 pm. Neighbors in the surrounding area will be informed and invited to the presentations as well. Request to begin negotiations will come before the City Council on March 16th.
- **Public Meeting for an Active Recreation Component on approximately 12 acres of City owned property north of Northridge Park between Clark Avenue and Live Oak Blvd.** On Thursday, February 18th the Parks and Recreation Department held a Public Input meeting at City Hall from 7:00 pm until 8:30 pm. Fourteen citizens attended which included neighbors of the surrounding potential project area, presidents of both Little Leagues and the Yuba Sutter Soccer Association. A lighted soccer complex of various sizes of fields that could facilitate a variety of uses, a marked walking path, playground, bathrooms, parking, and a concession stand were all components discussed and suggested in the meeting. Concerns included: speeding and additional traffic on Clark and Live Oak, lighting, noise, unauthorized after hour usage and maintenance standards. Input from this meeting will help with the application process for Prop. 84 funds that will be allocated in the next year and must be spent in the next six years.
