The Recreation Department will be wrapping up its Mighty Mite T-ball season Saturday May 15th. Each of the 276 participants will receive a trophy at the conclusion of their game.

- **Hershey Track & Field – Saturday May 22, 2010**

The Recreation Department will be hosting its 9th Annual Hershey Track Meet Saturday, May 22nd. The event will take place at Yuba City High School beginning at 9:00 am. 180 boys and girls ages 7 – 15 will be competing in a variety of events; the standing long jump, softball throw, 50 meter dash, 100 meter dash, 200 meter dash, 400 meter dash, 800 meter run, 1600 meter run and the 4 x 100 meter relay. The top three finishers in each event/age group will then advance onto the State Meet, which will be held in San Jose on June 19th.
