### **Parks & Recreation Department**

- **Two Athletes Head to National Meet – Hershey Track & Field**—On May 22, the Recreation Department held their annual Hershey Track and Field meet. The top three finishers in each event earned the opportunity to advance to the State Meet on June 19, in San Jose. A first place finish at the State Meet offers a potential trip to the 2010 National Meet in Hershey, PA. Yuba City had three athletes finish first in their events. Elisse White in the 100 and 200 meters, Dante Love in the 800 meters and Malachi Wharry in the softball throw. **We are proud to announce that Elisse's time in the 200 meters and Dante's time in the 800 meters has earned them a trip to Hershey, PA.** The athletes will leave on an all-expense paid trip August 4<sup>th</sup> and return August 8<sup>th</sup>. The National Meet will be held August 7<sup>th</sup>.
