Parks & Recreation Department

This publication will also be available at City Hall, the Recreation Department, Gauche Aquatic Park and the Senior Center, as well as at www.yubacity.net.

Public Works/Utilities

Walton Avenue and Franklin Road Improvements – Traffic has been shifted to the south side of Franklin Road to allow the contractor, Argonaut Constructors, to excavate and grade the north side of Franklin Road. The concrete subcontractor is installing curb and gutter on the north side of Franklin Road and then Argonaut Constructors will pave the first lift of asphalt concrete, which is tentatively scheduled for next week.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Primary Clarifier Rehabilitation – Public Works Department is soliciting bid proposals for the rehabilitation of the Primary Clarifier #2 at the Wastewater Treatment Facility. The work includes concrete repair and protective coating of the concrete and metallic components. Bids are due on September 1. It is anticipated that the project will be complete by mid December 2010, weather permitting.

Residential Resurfacing Project – The City’s Contractor, California Pavement Management, is wrapping up the resurfacing of various residential streets throughout the City. Work includes resurfacing approximately 12 miles of residential streets for the purpose of street maintenance. Work will extend the pavement life by providing a new riding surface, smooth depressions, and seal cracks. Work is expected to be completed by early September.

Sanborn Storage & Pumping Plant – Roof installation/welding in progress. Pump cans were installed on 8/10/10. Installing site underground. Completion anticipated in May 2011.

2010 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Progress Report -- The Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, originally published in 2007, is a multi-jurisdictional document which provides a plan to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards and their effects on the Sutter County Planning Area of California. The Department of Public Works has recently completed the annual progress report of the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. The progress report is available online for review at City’s Floodplain Management website at www.yubacity.net/flood. The report discusses the background of each Action Item which the City of Yuba City is responsible for and the progress made towards completion in the previous year.
