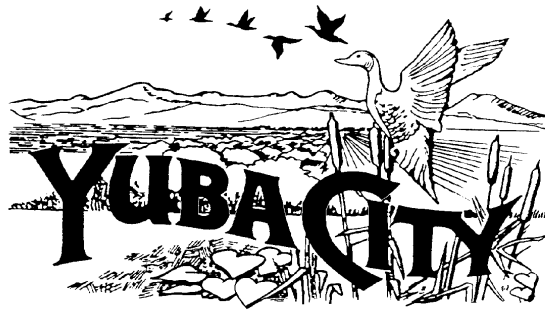

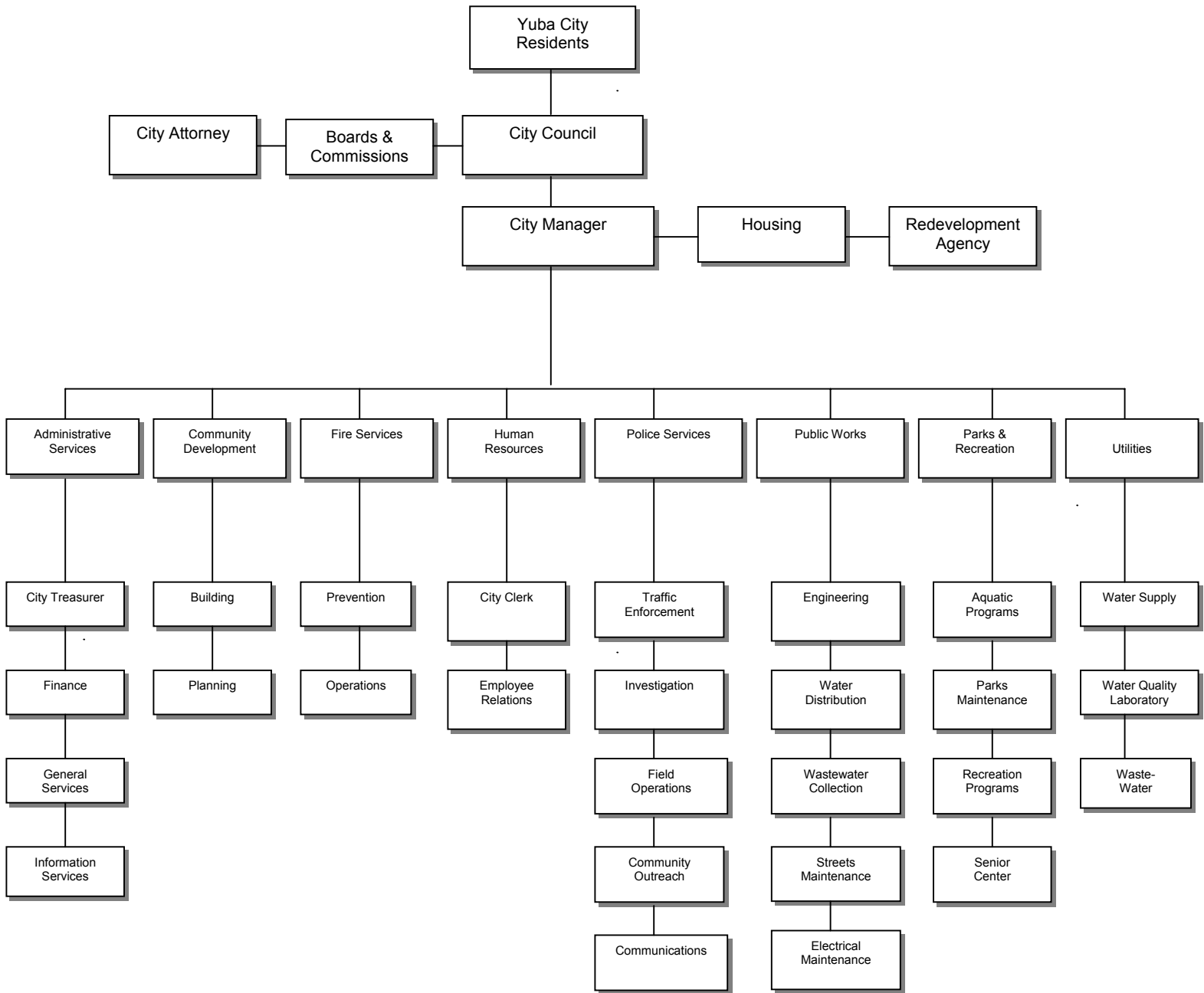
ABOUT THE COVER

Plumas Street Downtown Yuba City

Yuba City is about to enter a new phase in its redevelopment of downtown Plumas Street. After more than a decade of working on developing the south end of Plumas Street at Town Center, the City has refocused its efforts on the area between B Street and Colusa Highway. The City is very fortunate that there has been an active Downtown Business Association working to attract new business to the traditional downtown area. Mayor Bob Barkhouse and the City Council are supportive of the downtown revitalization, as the entire effort is part of the Specific Plan established by the Council. With all of the Redevelopment Agency-owned Town Center office-sites spoken for and buildings either completed, under construction, or in the final stages of planning, Yuba City's Redevelopment staff is redirecting its attention to the core downtown area and has hired a consulting firm to help the downtown businesses establish their collective identity. In order to have a thriving downtown, there needs to be a design and an atmosphere created where people want to shop and be entertained. Well-designed buildings and clean and safe streets are critical.

Luisa Leger is a multimedia artist, art teacher and designer. She is best known for her paintings of local and international scenes and historical buildings. Luisa is the winner of four consecutive Gold Awards and a Best of Show at the California State Fair Counties Booth competition. Luisa is a co-founding member of the Vision Arts Gallery at the Yuba City Mall, which showcases and sells art from local artists.

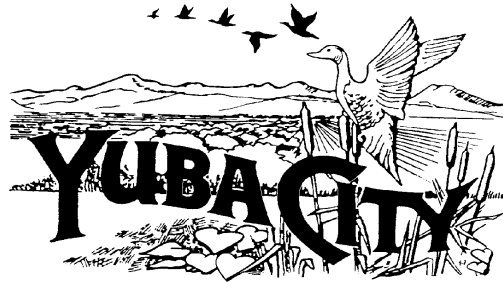
