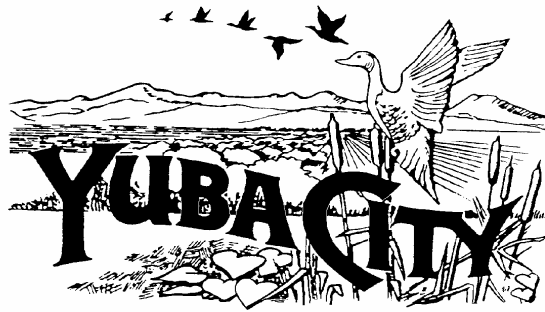

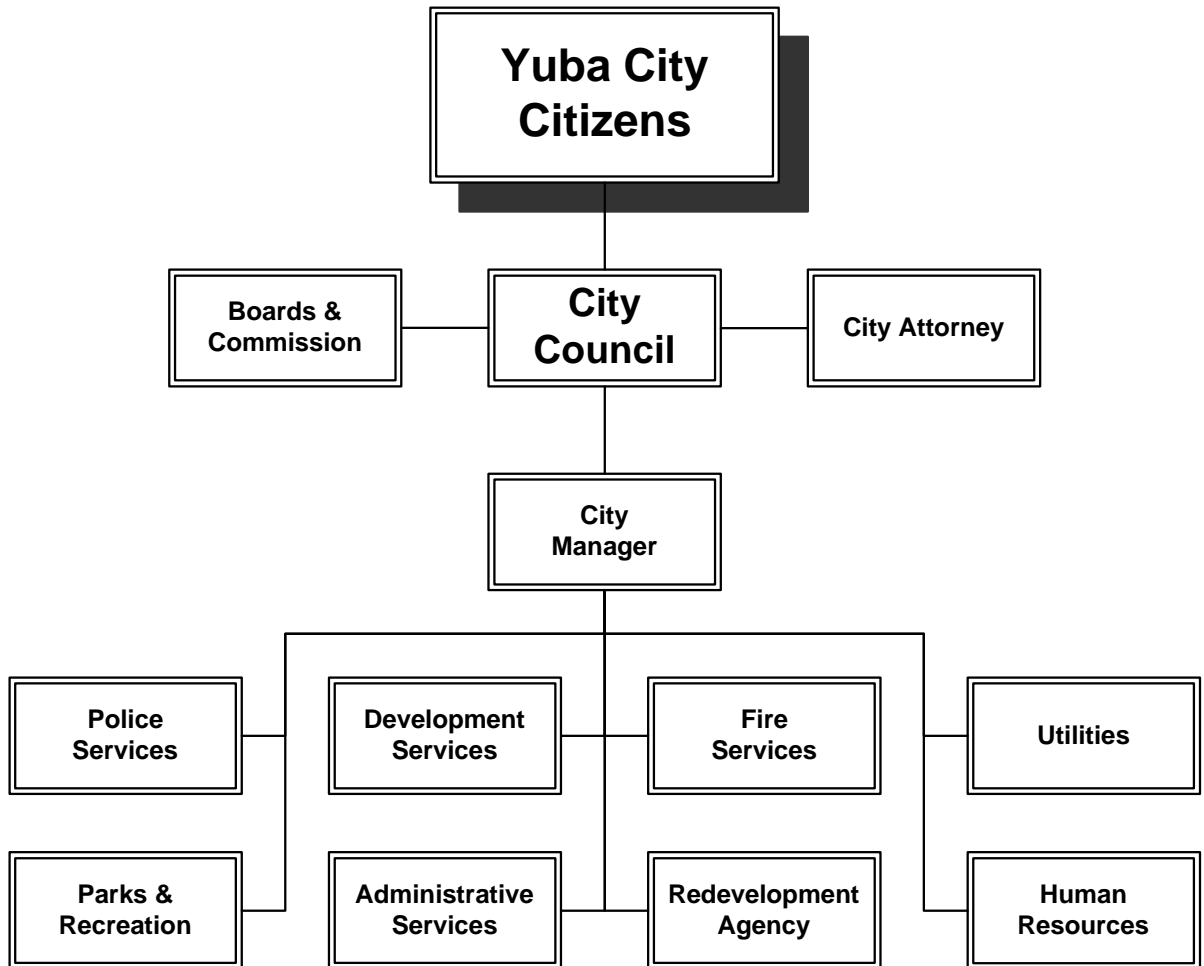

Regency Park

The City of Yuba City is proud to dedicate Regency Park - Yuba City's state-of-the-art neighborhood park in the summer of 2005. The 7.5 acre, \$1.4 million facility provides the Buttes Vista neighborhood an exquisite park that they assisted in creating. The landscape architect firm of Carter & Burgess, Inc. conducted a series of four public meetings with interested community residents. The community selected park amenities they felt would enhance their neighborhood. Regency Park features two separate playgrounds for two separate age groups, a children's water feature, a Parterre Garden (passive retreat area), a Gazebo located on a large knoll with a scenic view of the Sutter Buttes, an open sports turf area, a perimeter sidewalk for jogging and walking, and a perimeter of decorative fence.
