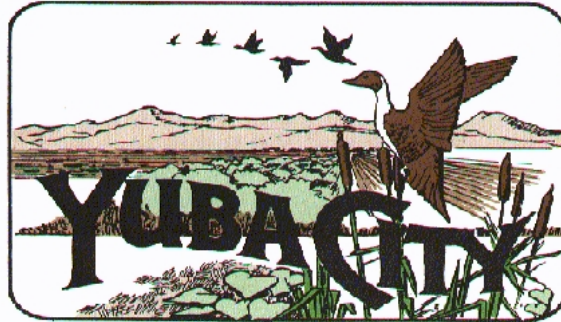

Plumas Streetscape Downtown Yuba City

2006 heralds the long awaited Plumas Streetscape project. After years of planning and design, construction on Yuba City's downtown street is set to begin. This project was first anticipated in the Central City Specific Plan and Revitalization Strategy adopted in 1992. The City initiated Plan implementation with construction of the Town Center, focusing on job creation and the development of a world-class civic space. The Town Center has become a cherished place for celebrating life in Yuba City.

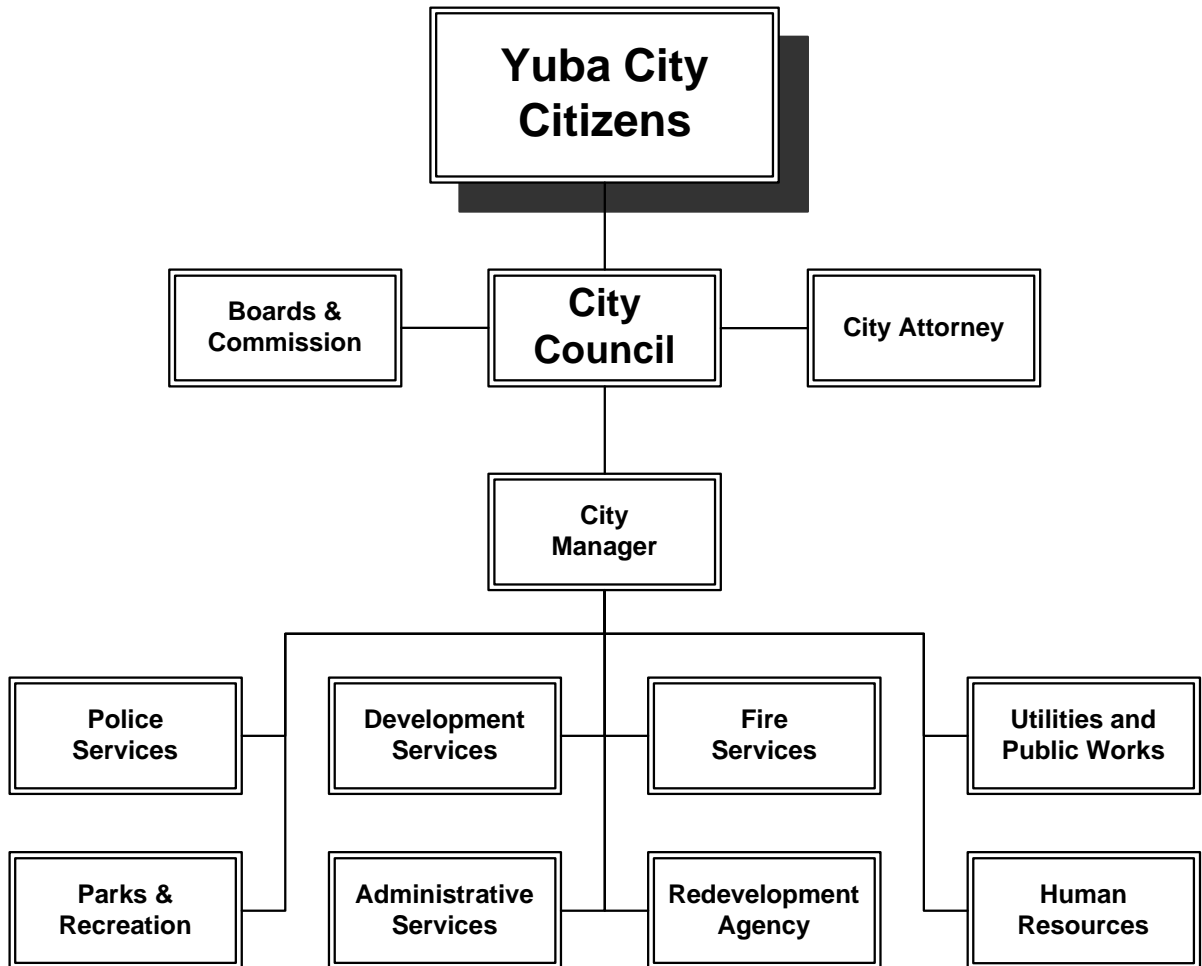
