I. CALL TO ORDER

The City of Yuba City Senior Commission Regular Meeting was called to order by Chairperson June Bone at 10:30 am at the Senior Center, 777 Ainsley Avenue, Yuba City.

VI. BUSINESS FROM THE COMMISSION

A. Council Meeting Report

1. February 16, 2010 – Commissioner Dettmer

- Recommended a Public Hearing on Zoning Code to establish standards for permanent installation of commercial coaches (portable buildings) for schools and offices.
- Overview of Zoning Code to establish procedures and standards for mobile and open air vendors to operate within the City. Convince Council to go back to committee.
- Overview of Zoning Code to allow an additional banner sign temporarily due to economic climate.
- Award a contract to install Solar Panels at Senior Center in the amount of \$222,650. Devin Barber gave an update on this project which is to begin in March.
- Award contract pertaining to Stimulus Street Rehabilitation on Live Oak Boulevard from State route 20 to Pease road in the amount of \$839,137.85.

2. March 2, 2010 – Commissioner Kogler
 - Overview to approve Grant Funding of \$100,000 for video cameras in police patrol cars or that can be worn by police officers.
 - Overview of CDBG Sidewalk Improvements of curbs and gutters for ADA standards in the amount of \$186,648.16.
 - Overview of contract award for Jamie Drive-Blevin Road Safe routes to School project in the amount of \$357,327.
 - Adopt an ordinance regarding additional temporary banners for businesses.
 - Adopt resolution to purchase parcel at 510 Boyd Street.
 - Approve request of Aztec Developers to be relieved of requirement to prepare a Master Plan for El Margarita Road to develop their property with an Independent Living Facility and Office Complex.
