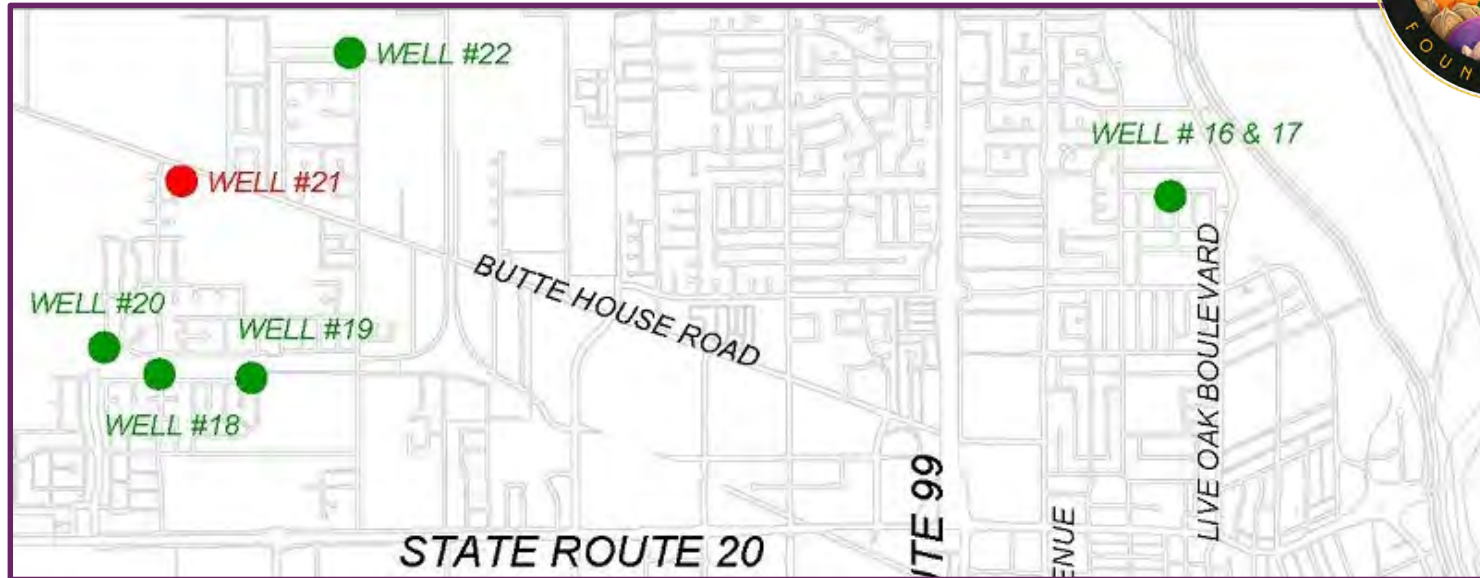
**18-06 Groundwater Well Abandonment Phase I Project –
Approval of Plans & Specifications**

Background



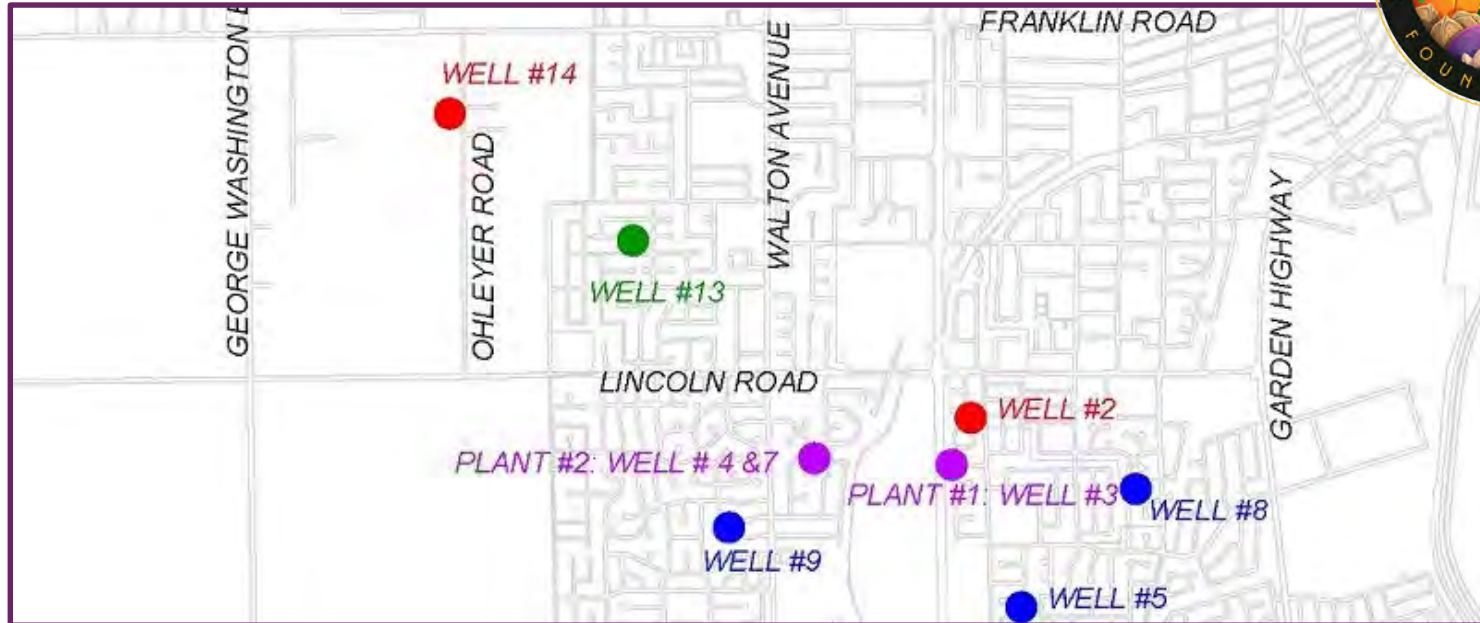
- Hillcrest Water Company purchased in 2001
 - 16 Groundwater Wells
 - All wells have been deactivated and 3 were abandoned in 2016
- Water Master Plan Update recommends abandonment of 10 wells due to water quality, infrastructure age, and improvement/treatment costs
- Abandonment of wells will be divided into 2 phases

Well Sites North of SR 20



- WELLS ABANDONED IN 2016
- WELLS FOR FUTURE EMERGENCY AND STORAGE USE
- WELLS TO BE ABANDONED WITH PROPOSED PHASE I PROJECT
- WELLS TO BE ABANDONED IN FUTURE PHASE II PROJECT

Well Sites South of Franklin



- WELLS ABANDONED IN 2016
- WELLS FOR FUTURE EMERGENCY AND STORAGE USE
- WELLS TO BE ABANDONED WITH PROPOSED PHASE I PROJECT
- WELLS TO BE ABANDONED IN FUTURE PHASE II PROJECT

Project Overview



- Phase I abandonment will include well sites 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, and 22
- Phase II abandonment will include well sites 3, 4, and 7
- Staff will return to Council with proposed actions and direction to divest sites

Estimate & Timeline



- Phase I – Engineer’s Estimate: \$370,000
 - CIP No. Account 1145 (Groundwater Well Abandonments)
- Project Timeline:
 - Advertise for Bid: Winter 2019
 - Award Contract: Spring 2019
 - Construction: Spring 2019
 - Completion: Summer 2019
