




2019 Striping and Marking Project Award

Project Scope

- 13 areas consisting of 42 locations
- 39,716 LF of thermoplastic striping
- 220 pavement legend improvements
- 28 crosswalk striping locations
- Addition of 20 signs
 - 12 of the 20 are R1-5 signs (“Yield here to pedestrians”)



Bid Results



- Crisp Company \$185,486.70
- Centerline Striping Co. \$210,255.00
- Central Striping Service \$258,833.80

- Engineer's Estimate \$162,000.00

- Only Stop for Gray Avenue Traffic
- Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety Concerns


Current Condition
