What is Yuba Sutter Arts?



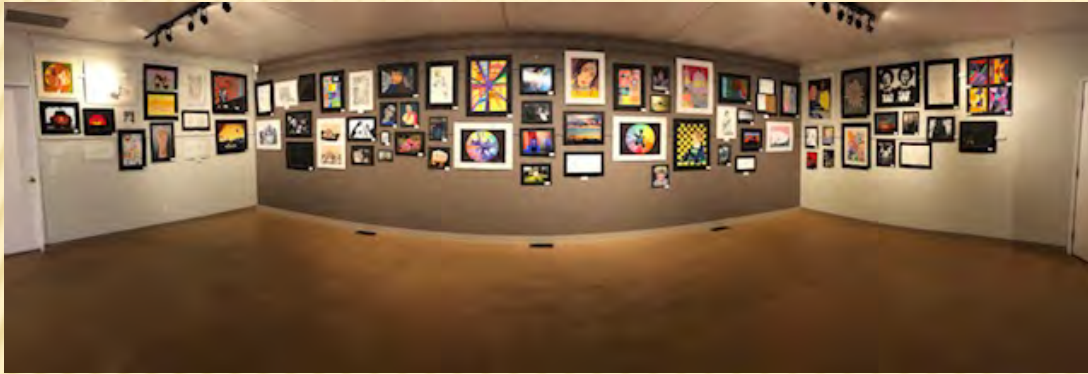

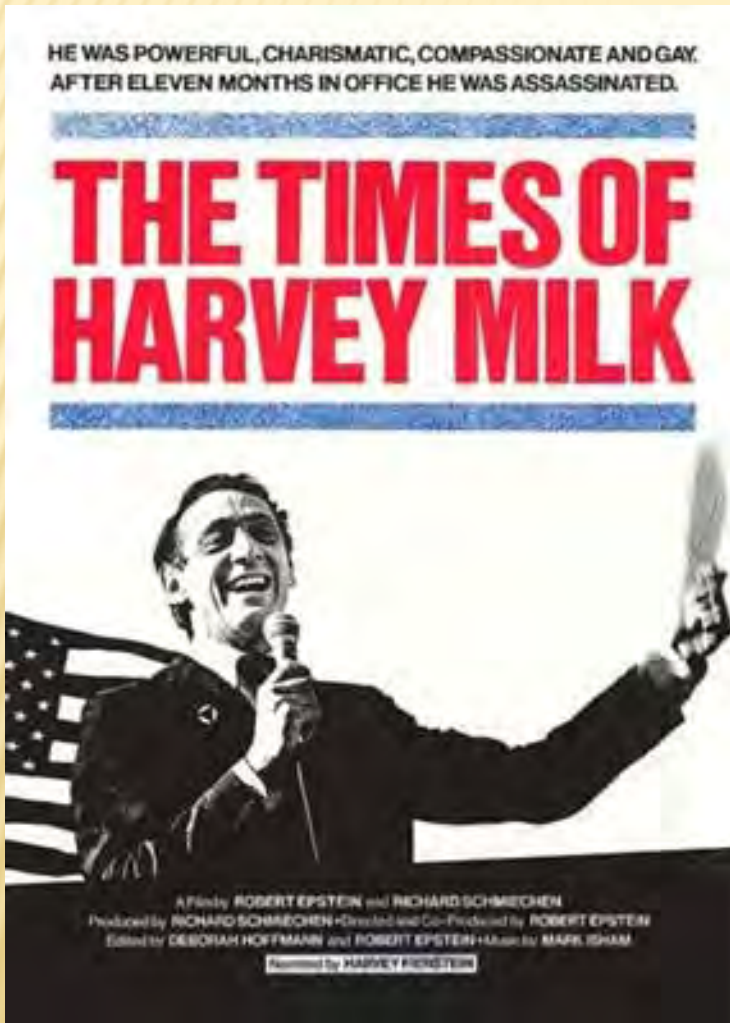

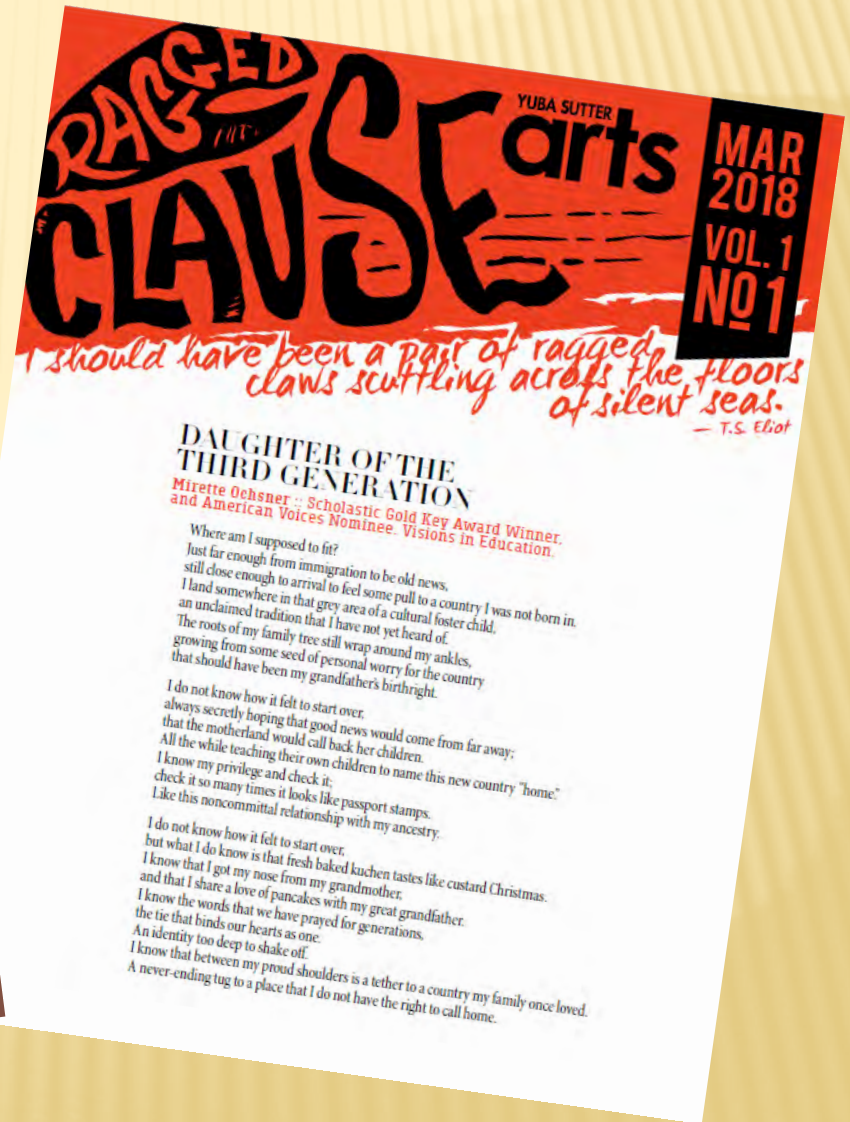

WHAT IS CULTURAL PLANNING?

- ✘ Cultural planning is a place-based process that generates a vision and action plan for strengthening and growing arts and cultural assets.
- ✘ Yuba Sutter Arts has taken on the leadership role in developing the plan in collaboration with all local arts and culture based organizations.
- ✘ The term “culture” and “cultural” are used to fully describe arts, culture, history, and humanities.



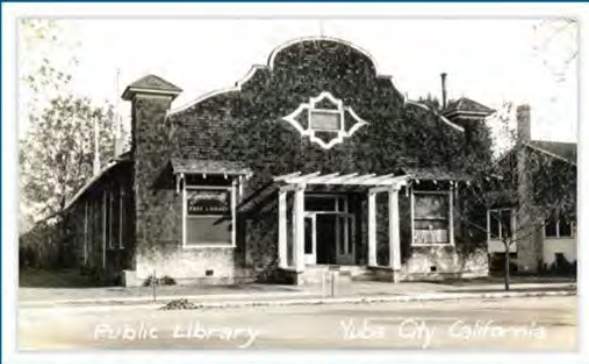
CULTURAL PLANNING

The planning process provides an opportunity for our entire region to:

- ✘ Expand and enhance cultural opportunities for the arts/creative community and for all residents
- ✘ Strengthen, leverage, and integrate artistic and cultural resources across all facets of local government to creatively advance broader objectives in the areas of economic development, social equity, the environment, and cultural tourism.

Cultural Plan Needs Assessment Survey – Research conducted by the Yuba Community College District
