- Cultural planning is a place-based process that generates a vision and action plan for strengthening and growing arts and cultural assets.
- Yuba Sutter Arts has taken on the leadership role in developing the plan in collaboration with all local arts and culture based organizations.
- The term "culture" and "cultural" are used to fully describe arts, culture, history, and humanities.




#### **CULTURAL PLANNING**

The planning process provides an opportunity for our entire region to:

- Expand and enhance cultural opportunities for the arts/creative community and for all residents
- Strengthen, leverage, and integrate artistic and cultural resources across all facets of local government to creatively advance broader objectives in the areas of economic development, social equity, the environment, and cultural tourism.
