Purpose:

To allow for community participation and discussion regarding the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) Unfunded Liability.

Background:

On March 19, 2019, Council considered and approved a request by Philip Treanor to form a Committee to review the issues and identify potential solutions to address the City's CalPERS unfunded liability.

On April 2, 2019, Mayor Harris noted that next steps for the formation of the Committee are to:

- Establish the ground rules, role, and scope of work of the committee
- Identify a meeting schedule

An additional necessary step is to identify the two Councilmembers that will steer the committee.

Analysis:

The two Councilmembers designated to steer the Committee will coordinate with staff to solicit citizen involvement, facilitate the meetings, identify necessary staff to participate in each meeting, and coordinate the preparation of a report with recommendations as applicable to the entire City Council.
