Background

- City of Yuba City is an entitlement jurisdiction receiving a federal formula grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- Intent of the program is to:
 - provide decent housing, a suitable living environment; and
 - to expand economic opportunities primarily for low and moderate income persons



Annual Reports

- Action Plan (June) outlines planned activities for the upcoming fiscal year
- CAPER (September) highlights the City's success in using CDBG funds to meet the housing and community development goals contained in the City's five-year Consolidated Plan (previous fiscal year)



Process

- HUD to Announce Funding Amounts (FY 18/19 \$650,001)
- Notice Sent to Past and Future Sub-Recipients
- Held a public workshop on February 6, 2019
- Applications were due March 13, 2019
- Reviewed the applications, rated, and ranked them on March 18, 2019
- Prepare Action Plan
- 30 Day Public Notice -- Prior to Council Consideration & Public Hearing
