**Purpose:**

**Background:**

The Youth Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council, City Manager and the Community Services Director in all matters pertaining to youth and all general matters concerning issues affecting youth and the City of Yuba City. The Commission consists of 9 members and 1 alternate serving 2-year terms. The Commission meets on the 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Sutter Room at City Hall and members must be between the ages of 14 and 19 years of age and reside within the City limits. Advertisements and notices for vacant positions were posted through Facebook, Instagram, and the Appeal Democrat.
