

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)



Background

- City of Yuba City is an entitlement jurisdiction receiving a federal formula grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- ■Intent of the program is to:
 - provide decent housing, a suitable living environment; and
 - to expand economic opportunities primarily for low and moderate income persons



Annual Reports

- Action Plan (June) outlines planned activities for the upcoming fiscal year, July 1, 2019 June 30, 2020
- <u>CAPER</u> (September) highlights the City's success in using CDBG funds to meet the housing and community development goals contained in the City's five-year Consolidated Plan (<u>previous</u> fiscal year)



Process

- Notice Sent to Past and Future Sub-Recipients
- Held a public workshop on February 6, 2019
- Applications were due March 13, 2019
- Reviewed the applications, rated, and ranked them on March 18, 2019
- Prepare Action Plan
- 30 Day Public Notice Published May 17, 2019 in Appeal Democrat



HUD Funding

- The City will receive \$647,714 for the 2019-2020 CDBG Fiscal Year
- 20% of funds will be allocated to Program Administration
- 15% of funds will be allocated for Public Services
