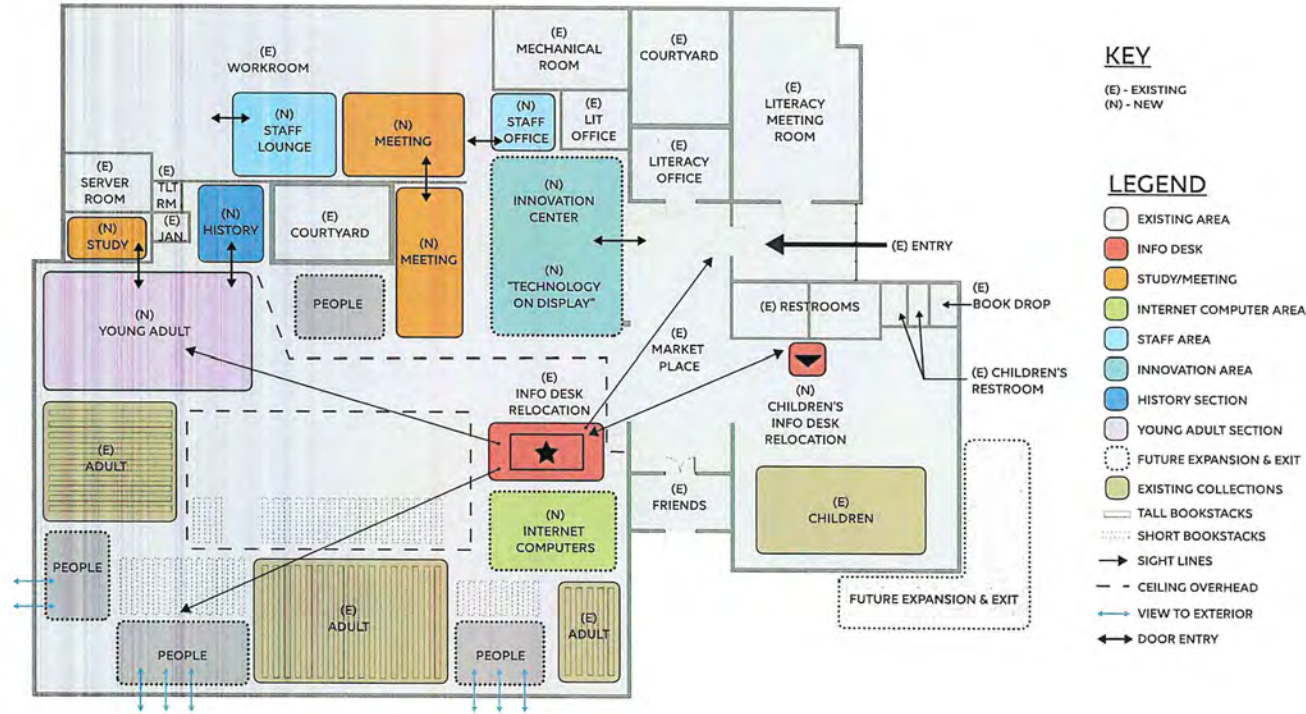


Background

- 2007 – Library Impact Fee was created to fund library-related capital costs attributable to the impact of new development
- Currently \$1,163,000 available

Sutter County Library Innovation Center

- According to a May 2nd letter from Steve Smith, Interim County Administrator, the “renovation project would enhance and expand services to the community within the existing library floor space, through the addition of the innovation center.”



Funding

- Sutter County is proposing to use County Library funds to fund the design portion of the project - \$177,617
- Sutter County requesting Yuba City Library Impact Fee funds to fund the construction portion – estimated at \$1 Million



Funding

- If Council is supportive of the County's request, staff will coordinate with the County at the time of project award to determine how much City Library Impact Fees will be transferred to the project



Recommendation

- Partner with Sutter County on the Library Innovation Center and commit to transfer up to \$1,163,000 in City Library Impact Fees to the project
