Options for Council to Consider:

FRAC Continue "as is" for a period of time.

City runs a Competitive Swim Team.

Direct Staff to find another Competitive Team or "satellite" opportunity.

Past Annual Revenue from FRAC

- Currently FRAC pays monthly fee of \$2,650
 - ➤ Annual revenue \$2,650 X 12 months = **\$31,800**

FRAC participant fees – remain the same

Revenues – Option #1

Younger/Novice Swimmer	40	\$70	12	\$33,600	
Older/Advanced Swimmer	20	\$75	12	\$18,000	
Projected Revenues = \$51,600					

Projected Revenues \$51,600

Projected Expenses - \$32,577

Option #1 Net Revenues \$19,023



Past Annual Revenue from FRAC \$31,800 Option #1 Net Revenues - \$19,023 Negative Annual Revenue = \$12,777



Option #2

FRAC participant fees – \$18 monthly increase per participant

- ➤ Younger/Novice Swimmer \$70 increased to \$88
- ➤ Older/Advanced Swimmer \$75 increased to \$93

Revenues – Option #2

Participant	# of participants	Fee	Months	Total	
Younger/Novice Swimmer	40	\$88	12	\$42,240	
Older/Advanced Swimmer	20	\$93	12	\$22,320	
Projected Revenues = \$64,560					

Projected Revenues \$64,560

Projected Expenses - \$32,577
