



- Safety / Maintenance issues
- CIP Multi-phased project
- LED lighting:
 - 81,000 hours 50fc infield, 30fc outfield light meeting softball, baseball safety standards.
 - 25 year warranty parts, labor, maintenance
 - Wireless controlled





Blackburn Talley Field Lighting Phase Two: Project Scope

- Original:
 - 8 poles
 - Metal halide fixtures
 - Pole-base connection near ground level with bolted connections
- Proposed:
 - Six poles (two shared, installed in Phase One)
 - LED Fixtures
 - Pole-base connection above ground level

Blackburn Talley Field Lighting Phase Two: Fiscal Impact

- Phase 1 competitive bid process \$349K (included shared lights an controller)
- Phase 2 Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (\$273K)
 - Based on previous bid results, City believes using Sourcewell Cooperative Program's nationwide bids will result in time and cost efficiencies.
 - Prime vs. Subcontracting
 - Warranty / Certified Electricians
 - Familiarity with Musco standards / setup
 - Allowed under City's Municipal Code/Procurement Manual Sourcewell / Musco is contracted to follow all applicable state laws / Prevailing wages apply
- Phase 3 CIP Budget 20/21 \$175K

Blackburn Talley Field Lighting Phase Two: Recommendation

- A. Adopt a resolution adopting a CEQA Class 1 Categorical Exemption; awarding a construction contract to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in the amount of \$272,824.85 by piggybacking on Sourcewell Contract No. 071619-MSL, with the finding that it is in the best interest of the City; and authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement for the Blackburn Talley Field Lighting Phase Two project.
- B. Authorize the Finance Director to make a supplemental appropriation and related transfers in the amount of \$26,466.09 from unallocated general capital improvement project funds to CIP Account No. 901234-65501 for the additional funds necessary to complete construction.
