# Stop Sign Installation – Rosalind Avenue at Olive Street

- Residential area requested a stop sign
- Stop sign is warranted due to:
  - A restricted view and the need to control left turns
  - Existing uncontrolled intersection
  - Offset legs for Rosalind Avenue
  - Restricted views





# Stop Sign Installation – Pease Road at E. Onstott Frontage Road

- History of sideswipe collisions and close calls
- High speeds and higher traffic volumes
- Restricted views for cross traffic
- Drivers unable to safely negotiate speeds





# Crosswalk Installation – George Washington Boulevard and Franklin Road



- No existing pedestrian crosswalks
- Improvements to provide dedicated stop controlled area for pedestrians



# Recommendation

- A. Adopt a resolution approving the installation of stop signs and stop legends in the eastbound and westbound directions of Rosalind Avenue at the Olive Street intersection and in the eastbound and westbound directions of Pease Road at the East Onstott Frontage Road intersection.
  
- B. Adopt a resolution approving the installation of crosswalks, stop bars, and stop legends on all sides of the North George Washington Boulevard and Franklin Road intersection.
