

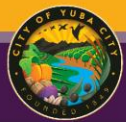

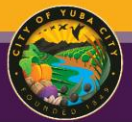

# SB 1383 Timeline and Targets



**2018 – Early 2020**

CalRecycle initiated formal rulemaking in 2018

Regulations to be adopted in early 2020



**January 1, 2020**

State to achieve 50% reduction of organics disposal (2014 baseline)



**January 1, 2022**

Jurisdictions must have organics recycling programs and ordinances in place



**January 1, 2024**

Jurisdictions must take progressive enforcement actions against non-compliant regulated entities



**January 1, 2025**

State to achieve 75% reduction in organics disposal (2014 baseline); State to recover 20% of edible food that would otherwise be disposed



# SB 1383 Readiness Assessment



## Collection & Processing

Partial programs are established but will need expansion for organics compliance.



## Monitoring & Enforcement

Contamination monitoring procedures will need to be developed and deployed.



## Edible Food Recovery

Collaboration will be needed among commercial edible food generators and food recovery organizations.



## Ordinances

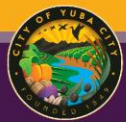
Mandatory organics, food recovery, and enforcement ordinances are needed for the entire service area.



## Product Procurement

The City's organic waste procurement practices will need to be modified to meet state-set quotas.

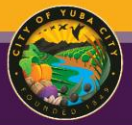

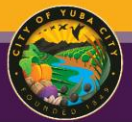

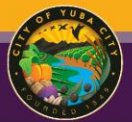




# Recommendations

  - iii. Reporting and Recordkeeping
  - iv. Infrastructure Planning
