# Background

- The California Department of Transportation, Division of Local Assistance has allocated funding for the City to produce a Systemic Safety Analysis Report (SSAR)
- One requirement for the allocated State funds is a 10% local funds match
- The City issued a Request for Proposals on January 17, 2020 and the deadline for submittals was February 14, 2020.



# Analysis

- The City received six proposals to develop a SSAR
- A Selection Committee evaluated each submittal based on SSAR guidelines established by the Department of Transportation
- TJKM Transportation Consultants submitted the top-ranked proposal

# **Fiscal Impact**

- \$139,696.09 is the total contract amount to be awarded
  - \$125,726.48 State Funds
  - \$13,969.61 Local Funds
- CIP Account No. 921244-65514 has sufficient funds available

Adopt a resolution awarding the development of a Systemic Safety Analysis report to TJKM Transportation Consultants of Pleasanton, CA in the amount of \$139,696.09, with finding that it is in the best interested of the City
