


Franklin Avenue Improvements Project – Layout Map



Franklin Avenue Improvements Project – Background

- City has obtained \$376,200 in Federal funds through Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Grant
- Franklin Avenue between S. Palora Ave & Gray Ave.
- Roadway in poor condition, storm drainage for only a portion of project limits, pedestrians & bicyclists do not have safe travel area.
- Some residents in project area do not have access to City utility services.
- Project will extend utility service stubs for future connections, install new storm drainage, rehabilitate roadway and widen roadway for bike lanes, parkway strips and sidewalks.

Franklin Avenue Improvements Project – Fiscal Impact

Construction Contract: \$1,178,143.22

Construction Contingency: \$ 150,000.00 (11%)

Construction Management: \$ 50,000.00 (4%)

Total Construction Cost: \$1,378,143.22

Streets and Roads funds through Account No. 1242: \$290,133.09
CDBG funds through Account No. 1220: \$270,255.24

Franklin Avenue Improvements Project Contingency and Construction Management Justification

- Staff is requesting a contingency of \$150,000 (11% of Construction Cost) and Construction Management of \$50,000 (4% of Construction Cost)
- Unpredictable variables associated with the project:
 - Construction and tie-in of utilities with unique properties
 - Potential conflicts with many utilities
 - Original concrete roadway lies under existing Franklin Ave

Franklin Avenue Improvements Project - Recommendation



Adopt a resolution awarding a construction contract to Darren Taylor Construction, Inc. of Anderson, CA in the amount of their total bid \$1,178,143.22 and authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract on behalf of the City, subject to review and approval as to legal form by the City Attorney.
