Definitions



- Senate Bill 1 (SB1):
 - Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 creating a gas tax and registration fees to fund road infrastructure improvements
- Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA):
 - Account where funding is deposited to be apportioned to cities and counties

SB 1 Funding



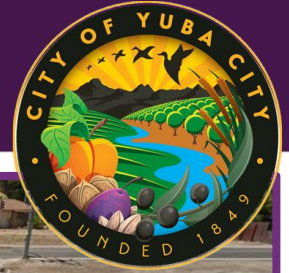
- SB1 RMRA fund approximate projections:
 - \$310,897.75 Fiscal Year 17/18 (actual)
 - \$1,066,860 Fiscal Year 18/19
 - \$1,244,222 Fiscal Year 19/20
 - \$1,275,542 Fiscal Year 20/21

Fiscal Impact



- Reduction in revenue from gas taxes due to COVID-19
- Local Streets and Roads Program has no new estimates
- California Department of Finance hasn't released revised revenue estimates for FY 19-20 or 20-21
- City currently anticipates receiving \$1,275,542 in RMRA funds for 20-21.
- There may be a reduction in funds due to reduced fuel consumption

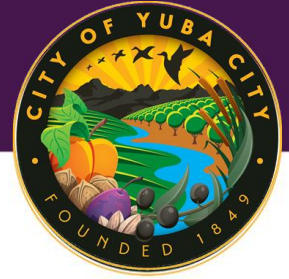


Location 1: Franklin Avenue – Palora to Gray
Construction: Summer 2020



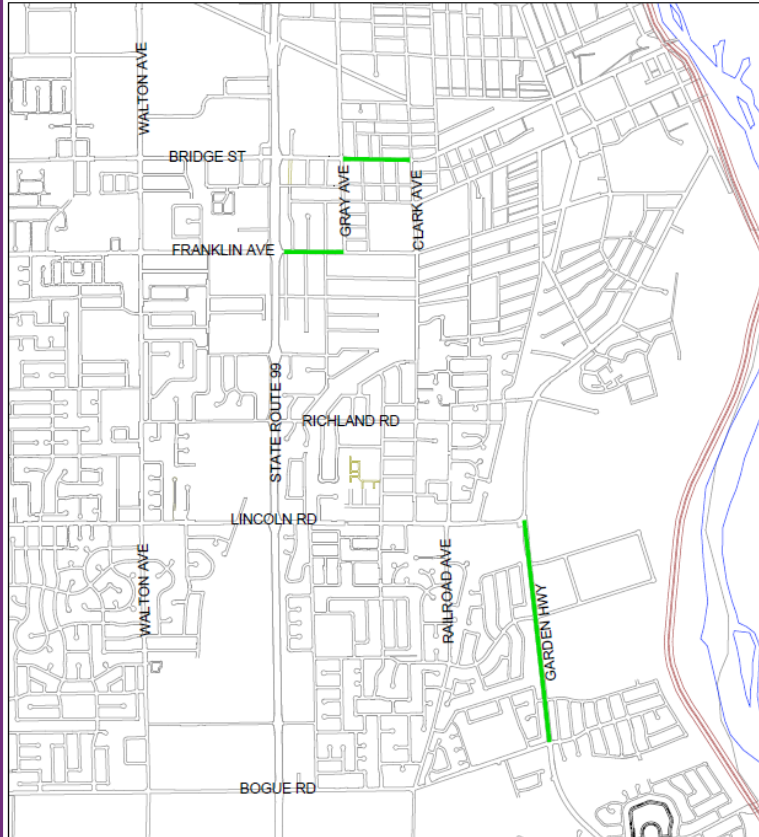
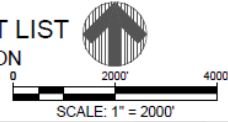
Location 2: Bridge Street– Gray to Cooper

Proposed Project Location Map



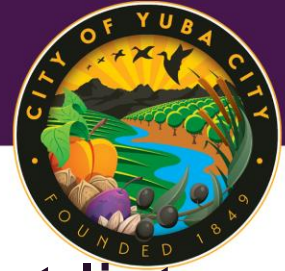
Proposed Project List
