

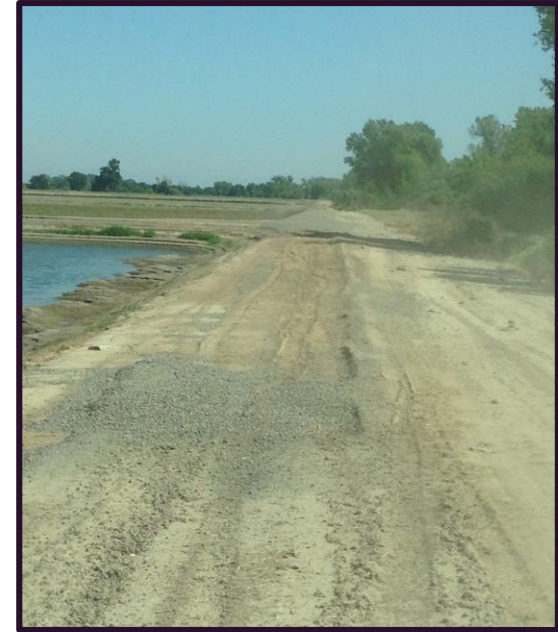
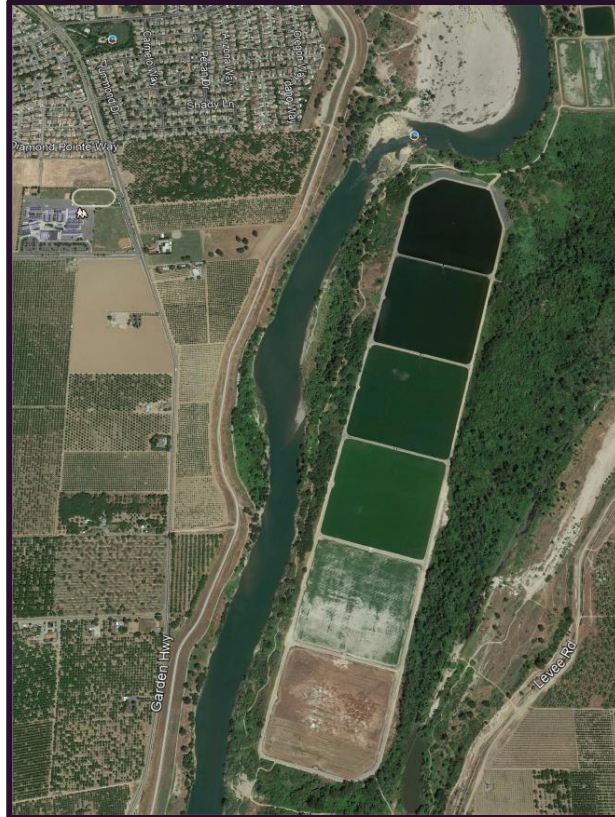

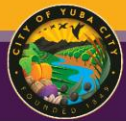
# 2017 Storm Damage Repairs – Ponds Site





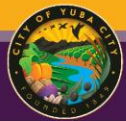
## 2017 Storm Damage Repairs – Background

- Requested Financial Aid to repair the damages from Cal-OES/FEMA
- Application for repairs has been approved
- FEMA also approved request to install riprap on four ponds
- Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. and MHM Engineering prepared bid documents
- Anticipated construction start - July 2020



## 2017 Storm Damage Repairs – Scope of Work

- Road repairs
- Ponds' slope repairs
- Ponds' bottom surface repairs
- Hazard mitigation work (riprap)
- Water conveyance system pipeline repairs/replacement

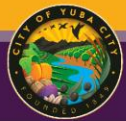


## 2017 Storm Damage Repairs – Fiscal Impact

**\$2,280,000 – Engineer's Estimate**

- \$1,205,000 eligible for FEMA reimbursement\*
- \$1,075,000 additional scope

**\*93.75% reimbursement by FEMA/Cal-OES**



## 2017 Storm Damage Repairs – Recommendation

Adopt a resolution approving the plans and specifications for the 2017 Storm Damage Repairs to the Yuba City Wastewater Effluent Discharge Ponds Project and authorize advertisement for competitive bids.
