



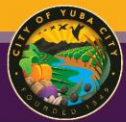

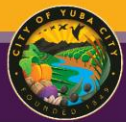

# Downtown Business Association Request



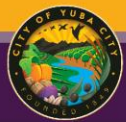
- Plumas Street Summer Marketplace
  - Close Plumas Street between Church Street and Bridge Street to allow businesses to expand their storefronts onto the sidewalk and street
- July 18, August 8, and an undecided date in September from 10 am to 5 pm

# Downtown Business Association Request

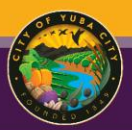


- Utilize \$7,500 that City contributed for the 2020 Summer Stroll
  - Funds will be used to purchase face masks, handwashing stations, rental of security, and entertainment
- In-kind request valued at \$2,531.70 for Public Works to close Plumas Street

# Downtown Business Association Request



- At the June 16<sup>th</sup> Council meeting, Council expressed support for the Marketplace contingent upon the following:
  - Submission of a formal sponsorship application
  - Authorization from Dr. Luu – **Dr. Luu will not issue written authorization. The DBA has received guidelines from John Floe of Sutter County Public Health and have confirmed that they can meet the guidelines.**
  - Order from the Director of Emergency Services (Interim City Manager) authorizing the temporary waiver of certain Municipal Code and entitlement restrictions



# Recommendation

- Confirm the Director of Emergency Services' Order for authorizing the temporary waiver of certain Municipal Code and Entitlement Restrictions for impacted businesses on Plumas Street
- Approve the sponsorship of the Plumas Street Summer Marketplace
