# Yuba City Lighting and Landscape District Nos. 2-6: Background

- City annually levies and collects special assessments to maintain lighting and landscaping improvements
- Assessments approved by property owners of record at the time Districts were formed
- District Nos. 2-6 have provisions for a cost of living adjustment (COLA)
- COLA is based on Consumer Price Index from January to January

### Yuba City Lighting and Landscape District Nos. 2-6: Analysis

- Engineer's Annual Report has been prepared
- Districts Nos. 2, 3, 5, and 6 will see increases in their annual levies while district 4 will see a decrease
- Assessments were raised in response to inflation
- District 4's assessment was decreased due to sufficient reserves and revenue which exceeded expenditures

## Yuba City Lighting and Landscape District Nos. 2-6: Fiscal Impact

| <u>District</u> | <u>Revenue</u> | <u>Expenditures</u> | Projected Reserve Fund Balance as of 7/1/21* |
|-----------------|----------------|---------------------|--|
| 2               | \$79,826       | \$76,751            | \$2,998                                      |
| 3               | \$11,500       | \$10,621            | \$18,143                                     |
| 4               | \$142,835      | \$125,219           | \$146,302                                    |
| 5               | \$510,553      | \$510,028           | \$285,466                                    |
| 6               | \$26,793       | \$20,084            | \$123,765                                    |


<sup>\*</sup>The Projected Reserve Fund Balance is the Total of the Capital Replacement Reserve plus the Operating Reserve.

### Yuba City Lighting and Landscape District Nos. 2-6: Alternatives


1. Council may direct the modification of the assessment amounts which will affect future revenue and expenditure amounts in FY 20/21, or cancel the Districts and find alternative funding sources to maintain the lighting and landscaping.

#### Yuba City Lighting and Landscape District Nos. 2-6: Recommendation


- A. Adopt the following resolutions to continue the Maintenance District, pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972:
  - Resolution Describing Improvements and Ordering the Engineer of Work to File a Report with Regard to Yuba City Lighting and Landscape Maintenance District Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6
  - Resolution Approving Engineer's Reports, Yuba City Lighting and Landscape Maintenance District Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6
  - Resolution of Intention to Order Improvements, Yuba City Lighting and Landscape Maintenance District Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6
- B. Set a public hearing for August 18, 2020 at 6:00 PM to establish assessments for FY 20/21












































