Summary

Subject: 2020 Striping and Markings Project (Plans & Specifications)
Recommendation: Adopt a Resolution which adopts a CEQA Class 1 Categorical Exemption, approves the plans and specifications for the 2020 Striping and Marking Project, and authorizes advertisement for bids on the project.
Fiscal Impact: Engineer’s Estimate \$200,000 – Account No. 1024 (Striping and Markings)

Purpose:

To promote vehicle and pedestrian safety by repairing and adding striping, crosswalks, and pavement markings at various locations throughout the City.

Background:

The City’s current pavement markings and safety striping is deteriorating at various locations around the City due to age. Replacement of faded traffic striping, pavement markings, crosswalks, and bike path striping along City roadways will decrease the potential for pedestrian and vehicular incidents and improve the safety of the City’s residents. The locations to be addressed are provided as Attachment 2.

Analysis:

Public Works has prepared the project plans, specifications, and cost estimate for the 2020 Striping and Marking Project. The focus of this project was to identify sections of roadways that have raised pavement markers, and replace those pavement markers with thermoplastic striping and reflective markers. Scope of work includes replacing existing centerlines, bike lane lines, and intersection related striping, as well as replacing existing crosswalks with high visibility crosswalks at select locations within the areas shown in Attachment 2.

With Council approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids, staff proposes the following schedule:

Advertise for Bid:	August 2020
Award Contract:	October 2020
Start of Construction:	November 2020
Completion:	December 2020

The plans and specifications for the project are on file in the Public Works Department at City Hall and at <http://www.yubacity.net/publicworksplans>.

Construction management and inspection will be administered by the City's Public Works Department staff.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated total project cost is \$200,000. This estimate includes contingency and construction management costs. CIP Account No. 1024 (Striping and Markings) has adequate funding programmed for this project.

Environmental:

Staff has performed a preliminary environmental assessment of this project and has determined that it falls within the Class 1 Categorical Exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, as the installation of striping, markers, and markings within existing City facilities are defined as repairs, maintenance, or minor alterations of existing public facilities, involving negligible or no expansion. Further, none of the exceptions to Categorical Exemptions set forth in CEQA Guidelines 15300.2 apply to this project.

Alternatives:

- A. Provide staff with alternative direction regarding priority locations
- B. Cancel proposed project

Recommendation:

Adopt a resolution which adopts a CEQA Class 1 Categorical Exemption, approves the plans and specifications for the 2020 Striping and Marking Project, and authorizes advertisement for bids on the project.

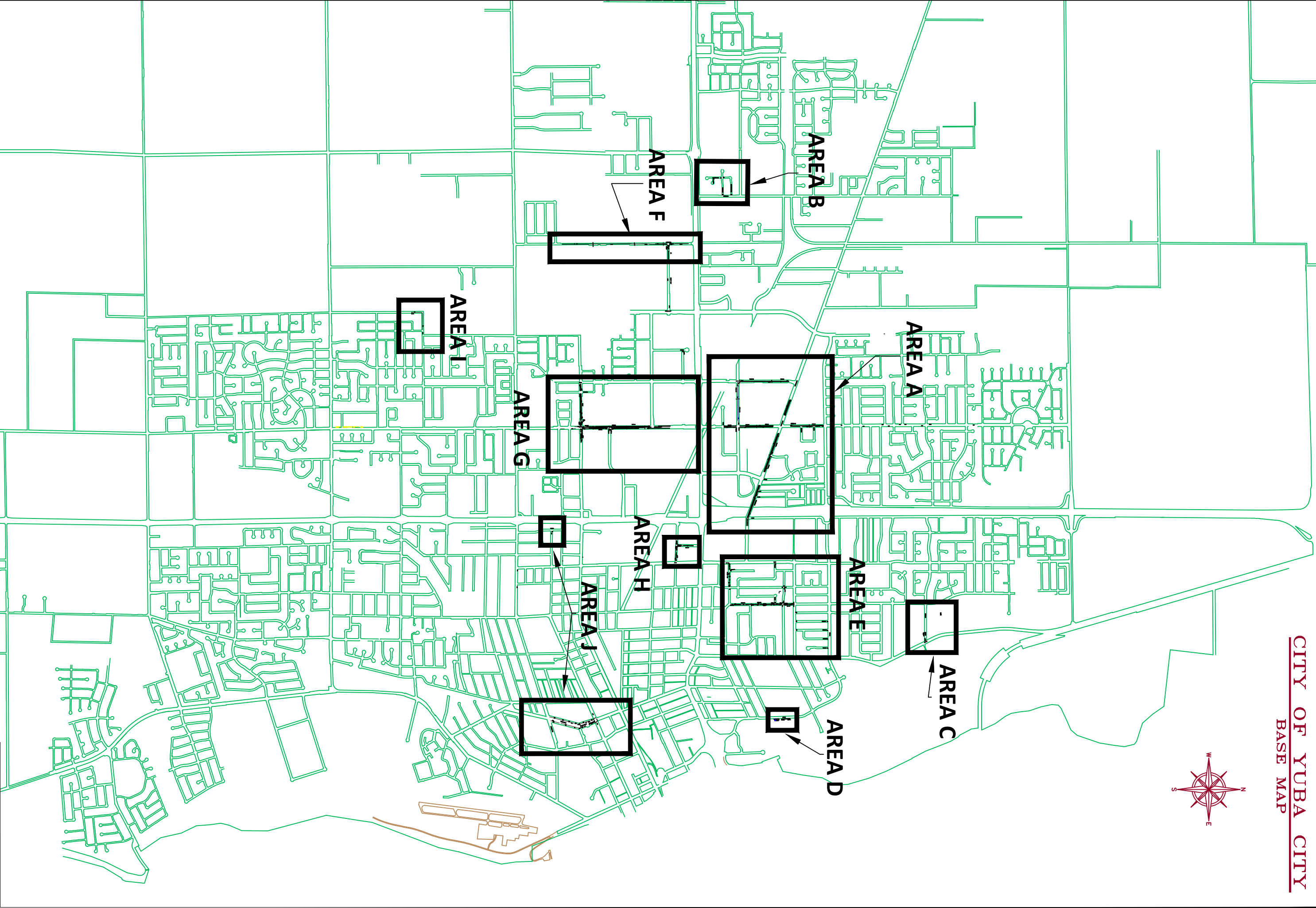
