





2020 Striping and Marking Project – Background

- Striping and markings are deteriorating at various locations throughout the City.
- Replacement of traffic striping, markings, crosswalks, and bike lanes will decrease potential for pedestrian and vehicular incidents and improve safety.
- Improvements focused on replacing raised pavement markers with thermoplastic, as well as locations identified from YC311 requests.

2020 Striping and Marking Project – Vicinity Map






2020 Striping and Marking Project – Scope of Work Table

Area	Streets	Scope
Α	- Butte House Rd - Stabler Ln - Poole Blvd - Tharp Rd	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic striping Directional arrows for New Earth Market driveway (yc311 requests)
В	San Niccolo Dr San Gimignano Dr Via Roma Way Firenze Ct	Residential neighborhood related striping, such as stop related striping and crosswalks
С	Water Treatment PlantNorthgate Dr	Parking Lot related striping Stop related striping at Live Oak Blvd
D	Corporation Yard	Parking Lot related striping
E	Clark Ave Ainsley Ave	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic Blike lane related striping Stop related striping Installation of High Visibility Crosswalks at Clark Ave and Rosemary Ave
F	– El Margarita Rd	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic striping Install high visibility crosswalk for El Margarita and Spirit Way Intersection related striping for Spirit Way intersection
G	- Walton Ave - Bridge St - Klamath Lane	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic Installation of class 2 bike lane (with buffer zone) Sunsweet related striping Stop related striping
н	Louise AveRocca Way	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic Intersection related striping
I	Cherry St Sanborn Rd	Turn related striping where roads meet
J	- Plumas Blvd	Replace raised pavement markers with thermoplastic striping and red-clear reflectors High visibility crosswalk for Plumas Blvd and B St
