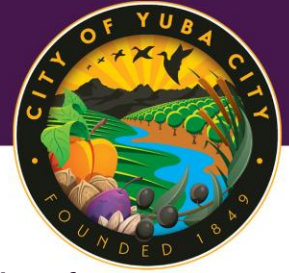

# Feather River Parkway Phase 1 Repairs Background



- In 2008 City received \$1,400,000 from Natural Resources Agency's California River Parkway Grant Program to fund Phase I of the Feather River Parkway Project
- Phase I completed in 2013
- Improvements severely damaged during 2017 Oroville Spillway Incident
- City applied for public assistance to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) for repairs and reconstruction of damage facilities
- FEMA awarded City \$789,567.26 to fund design and construction
- November 19, 2019, City Council awarded a Professional Services Agreement to Domenichelli for design, project management, and environmental services for the repair Project

# Feather River Parkway Phase 1 Repairs Analysis



- Domenichelli and Associates has prepared plans specifications and estimate for project
- With Council approval of plans and specifications, and authorization to advertise for bids, staff proposes the following schedule:

Advertise for Bid:	August 2020
Award Contract:	September 2020
Start of Construction:	Fall 2020
Completion:	Winter 2020
- Construction management and inspection to be performed by City's Public Works Department Staff
- City is communicating with CALOES and FEMA regarding project timeline
- Staff hopes to extend project deadline into next year to avoid any potential delays due to working near the river during the winter months, or high-water events that may hold up construction in the winter/spring

# Feather River Parkway Phase 1 Repairs

## Fiscal Impact



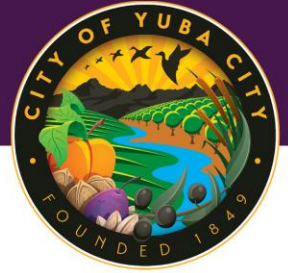
- Total FEMA/CalOES grant funding provided for the Project was \$789,567.26
  - FEMA contributing 75%, CalOES 18.75%, and the City 6.25% (approximately \$52,640)
- Design and bidding costs are estimated at approximately \$150,000
  - Approximately \$639,000 in grant funding available for construction. The total estimated construction cost is \$614,000
- At time of award, staff will request to appropriate unallocated General and Water Fund unallocated funds to CIP Account No. 1273 for construction, contingency, and construction management costs
- After project completion, CalOES and FEMA will reimburse their respective share of the construction and construction management costs
- Detailed fiscal impacts will be presented to Council at the time of award based on actual bid amounts

# Feather River Parkway Phase 1 Repairs Alternatives



- Instruct staff to direct Domenichelli and Associates to modify the plans and specifications
- Schedules and funding sources will be impacted

# Feather River Parkway Phase 1 Repairs Recommendation



- Adopt a resolution approving the plans and specifications for the FEMA Feather River Parkway Repair Project and authorizing advertisement for bids on the project
