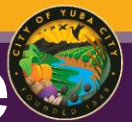

# Sutter County LHMP Update Necessity



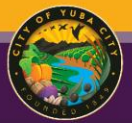
- Intended to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards
- Required to be eligible for federal disaster mitigation funding
- Impacts the City's Community Rating System classification through FEMA for the National Flood Insurance Program

# Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee



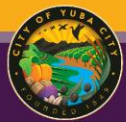
- Necessary to create a Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee (HMPC) to meet and fulfill FEMA requirements
- HMPC will be comprised of:
  - Representatives of various city and county departments, special districts, other federal, state, and local agency stakeholders, and the public

# Fiscal Impact



- Sutter County received a FEMA mitigation grant for the update of the LHMP
- City fiscal impact is staff time to participate in the development of the LHMP

- Adopt a Resolution to establish a Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee and update the 2013 Sutter County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan
