## Background

- In 2017, the City utilized \$100,000 in SACOG funding for revitalization streetscape improvements on SR20 between Clark Ave and Stafford Way.
- On April 2, 2019, Council authorized the City Manager to execute a MOU with SACOG to access another \$100,000 in Community Design Program Grant funds for additional improvements to the SR20 Corridor.
  - Council requested staff return with potential options for Phase 2 of the SR20 Corridor improvements.





#### Fiscal Impact


- Each proposed improvement option is estimated to cost approximately \$135,000, including design, construction and 10% contingency.
- Funding will be through CIP Account No. 1254 (State Route 20 Corridor Improvements)

#### Available balance:


- \$100,000 Community Design Program Grant
- \$35,000 TDA Fund
- \$91,000 General Fund
