A Grateful Nation Remembers

May 29-30, 2021

WHEREAS, Memorial Day we pause in solemn gratitude to pay tribute to the brave patriots who laid down their lives defending peace and freedom while in military service to our great Nation. We set aside this day to honor their sacrifice and to remind all Americans of the tremendous price of our precious liberty; and

WHEREAS, in 1992 **Michael A. Ciociola**, Lead Pastor at Calvary Christian Center began Memorial Day ceremonies, to provide his congregation and community an avenue to pay honor and tribute to veterans and military personnel who have paid the price for the freedoms we as Americans enjoy today; and

WHEREAS, Calvary Christian Center members provide set design, construction, and actors. Over 200 church members participate in the ceremonies. Many Beale AFB Airman volunteer for the construction and community assistance for the Freedom's Heroes Outdoor Memorial, train medical reenactors and erect the Alaskan Tent for the Afghanistan Field Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the memorial display has developed throughout the years capturing the tributes and dedications of our great fallen heroes:

- 1994 Vietnam Wall (3 panels)
- 1995 Tomb of the Unknown Soldier Added
- 1996 Vietnam Bearcat Field Hospital Added: 2 Panels Added to Vietnam Wall
- 2001 Present 6-Panel Vietnam Wall Constructed
- 2002 9/11 Tribute *Added* (Firemen/Twin Towers)
- 2003 War on Terror Tribute (Tumbling of Saddam Hussein Statue)
- 2004 War on Terror Tribute (Honoring Current Military Personnel)
- 2005 War on Terror Tribute (Iraqi Voters); The Moving Wall on display
- 2006 War on Terror Tribute (Salute to the Fallen) Freedoms Heroes War on Terror Memorial Constructed (East Park Area)
- 2007 Tribute at Arlington 4 Panels Added to Freedoms Heroes Memorial
- 2008 Present Panels added annually as needed. As of 2021, a total of 21 panels
- 2015 Afghanistan Field Hospital Added
