

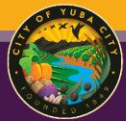


Cal OES 2020 Community Power Resiliency Allocation – Receive Grant Funding and Authorize Purchase June 15, 2021



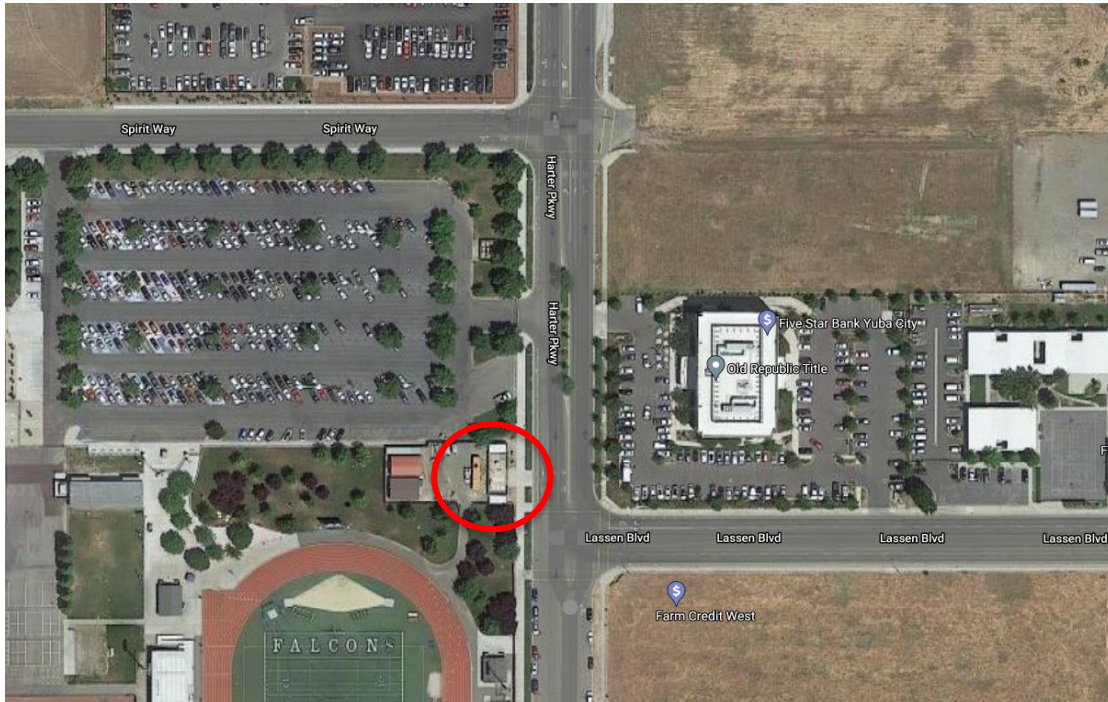
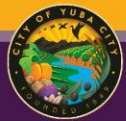

Background



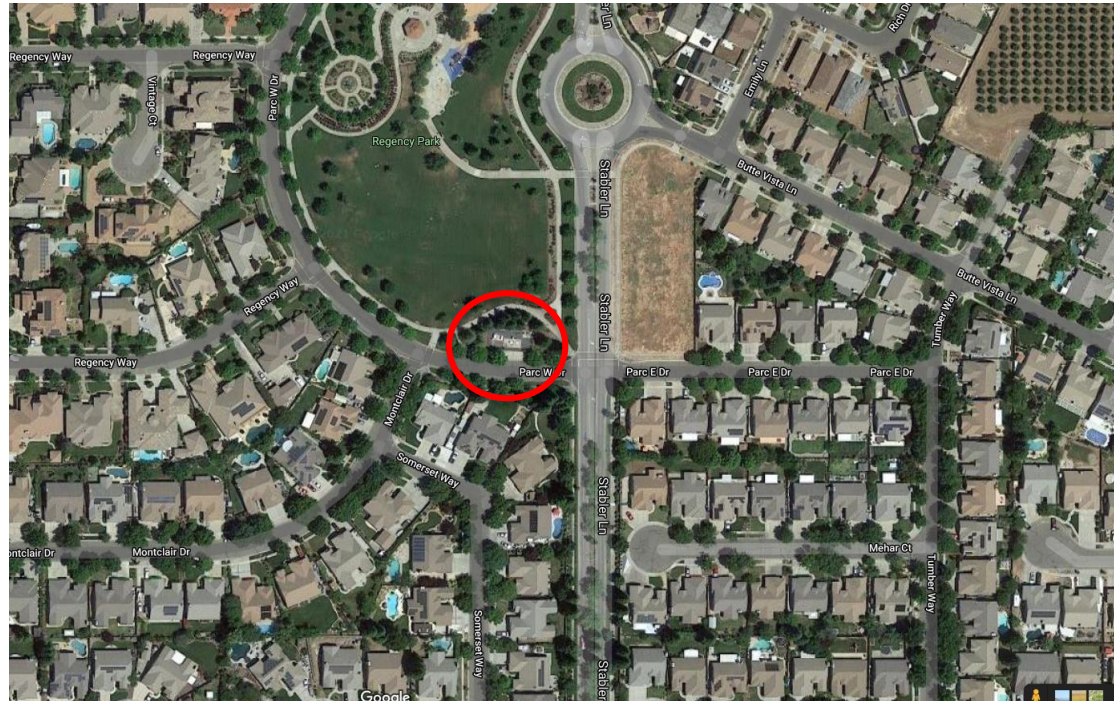
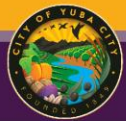
- On October 9, 2020, Cal OES released a request for proposals for the Community Power Resiliency Allocation to Cities Program
- City submitted an application for the installation of two emergency generators at sanitary sewer lift Stations #3 and #14 as identified for the Public Safety Power Shutdown program.
- On March 12, 2021, Cal OES notified the City that it approved the City's full amount of \$236,000
- On April 12, 2021, the Finance Department received a check from Cal OES for the full allocation amount.

Location Map



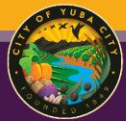
Lift Station #3 – Lassen Blvd and Harter Pkwy

Analysis



- Staff solicited three (3) quotes for generator equipment. Requests were also provided to local builder/contractor exchanges.
- On May 10, 2021, three (3) quotes were received electronically as follows:

<u>Company</u>	<u>Bid Amount</u>
Bay City Electric Works, Poway, CA	\$61,224.74
Consolidated Electrical Distributors, Yuba City, CA	\$65,063.21
Platt, Beaverton, OR	\$79,513.00

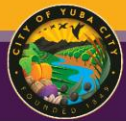
Bay City Electric Works is the low, responsible, responsive bidder.

Contract administration, installation, and inspection will be performed by Public Works Staff.



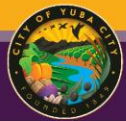
Fiscal Impact

- \$236,000.00 – CIP Account No. 1105 (Lift Station Improvements).
 - \$61,224.74 – Equipment Purchase
 - \$100,000.00 – Construction
 - \$24,775.26 – Construction Contingency
 - \$50,000.00 – Engineering and Administration
- Grant funding not utilized by the City will be returned to Cal OES.



Recommendations

- Approve the mid-year capital acquisition of two (2) Kohler 30kW Emergency Generators and one (1) Automatic Transfer Switch.
- Authorize the supplemental appropriation and related transfers of CalOES Community Power Resiliency Allocation to Cities Program grant funding in the amount of \$236,000.00 to Account No. 941105-65501.
- Adopt a resolution awarding the purchase of two (2) 30kW Emergency Generators and one (1) Automatic Transfer Switch from Bay City Electric Works of Poway, CA in the amount of \$61,224.74, with the finding that it is in the best interest of the City.
